Biblical Months fall under the Law Form of YHWH (Yahweh), Father-Son-Holy Spirit, through the revelation of His Word.

**The Biblical day begins at sundown, and ends at sundown the following day. At sundown, it is known as the dawning of a new day. Genesis 1:5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

The Amplified, King James, New American Standard and Passion versions of the WORD of GOD were used in this study. Words of Prophecy from: Lana Vawser, Doug Addison, John Belt, Chuck Whitbread with additional quotes are from sermons and the book "A Time To Advance" by Chuck Pierce with Robert and Linda Heidler.

It's been one year and one month since we started publishing the Republic Prayer Calendar based on the Hebrew Lunar Cycle so for anyone joining us for the first time I want to give some background. In Genisus1:1 the very first words GOD speaks is "In the beginning" and according to Rabbinical teaching, the very first commandment given to the children of Israel while in Egypt was to sanctify the "New Moon". From that point on the nation of GOD was to look at the Moon for the setting of their days and evenings and as a means to reconcile the times and seasons. The Biblical day begins at sundown, and ends at sundown the following day. At sundown, it is known as the dawning of a new day. Genesis 1:5, And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day. History is set into motion as God said that the world may be understood as a day equaling 1,000 years and a 1,000 years as a day. He states that the last 7th, 1,000 year of days would be the time being the Millennial Reign of Christ. We are there now. Close enough to recognize the signs of the times. Look at this month, Tammuz, this year the new moon appeared on June 11th not the 12th as predicted. Keep in mind that the calendar is processed a week in advance whenever possible.

The Lunar cycle has only 29.5 days or 354 days per year whereas the solar cycle has 365 days per year. An additional month is added every 3rd year to coordinate with the solar calendar for agricultural seasons. The reason the numerical date may not look like the previous years is because of this shift. The Month begins with the rising of the "New Moon". The Hebrew year begins in spring every year in the Month of Nissan when Passover occurs. Every month is related to a specific tribe, feast and season.

We are beginning the month of Tammuz so keep in mind that man changed the calendar, GOD didn't.

The Biblical Month of Tammuz*, begins this year at sundown on June 12th to sundown July 12, 2018.

The month of Tammuz (June/July) is linked to the tribe of Reuben which means "behold a son". Jacob prophesied "Reuben, you are my first born, my might, the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, the excellency of power." Reuben fell when he let his eyes and heart wander and committed

a horrible sin against his father and more importantly the LORD. It's the month to guard your heart and eyes and not build any "Golden Calves" in your lives. (Deut. 11:26, 30: 15-19). Therefor we get, "Behold the SON; Let HIM guard your Heart and Eyes." It's a time for vision; keep your eyes on the LORD. It is so easy to fall into worship of other things than the LORD: money, position, people; even the Republic. Keep in mind our priorities are Christ, HIS Kingdom, family then look at work, duties and the Republic.

Last year at this time Dr. Tim Sheets saw Heaven open and a myriad of Angels were descending. He asked the LORD who they were and FATHER said "These are Angels of Alignment, sent to bring MY people into Covenant position.

The Prophets today are speaking a word of Alignment. That Alignment is based on GOD'S great GRACE. "It's a Season of GRACE!" There's GRACE to go up higher to a new administration and governmental realm (Dutch Sheets, Dr. Robert Heidler and Dr. Chuck Pierce).

- There's GRACE to come out of the confusion, disarray and disorder.
- There's GRACE to bind and loose.
- There's GRACE to open doors and close doors.
- There's not just GRACE or <u>Double GRACE</u>, <u>but TRIPLE GRACE</u>! The LORD is releasing an explosion of grace!

It is a Word from the Lord! It's an explosion of GRACE this season and it's begun! We're about to move into a MEGA GRACE Season! I'm not decreeing that just as a hope; I'm prophesying to you as a Word from the Lord. We're about to move into a MEGA GRACE season that will be explosive in nature! We need to examine our lives this month and see how we align for the rest of the year. What has changed this past year that will cause a re-alignment? Was there an increase in blessings from the previous years? What did GOD say this past year prophetically about us and have any of those words come to pass?

We need to worship GOD like never before as we press into the new season before us that we may be able to receive all the FATHER has for us and know how to use what HE gives for the future.

Tammuz 1: Wednesday June 13, 2018 A Prophetic Word: Chuck Whitbread

A word was given to me this week when I was awakened at 4:30 in the morning. The LORD said "Tell the Josephs that Benjamin is coming". I asked the HS specifically what FATHER was saying and HE said, "My children could not have their provision that had been stored by Joseph for the next seven years until Benjamin came". "Tell the Josephs, Benjamin is coming and provision is being released, the gates and doors are opening". Glory to God

we are in the time of release, finances, freedom, health and revelation. Genesis 43:16

[Joseph Sees Benjamin] When Joseph saw Benjamin with them, he said to the steward of his house, "Bring the men into the house, and kill an animal and make [a meal] ready; for the men will dine with me at noon."

And he looked up and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's [only other] son, and said, "Is this your youngest brother, of whom you spoke to me?" And Joseph said, "God be gracious to you and show you favor, my son."

Tammuz 2: June 14, 2018

The Golden Calf: It's the month to guard our heart and eyes and not build any "Golden Calves" in our lives. Take time to look at all the times GOD has saved you, blessed you and bailed you out of situations. It is easy to look at the children of Israel and judge them for falling so many times when we do the same, over and over again. Never take your eyes off of the promise in HIS WORD and look for idols. If you fall go back to HIS Amazing Grace and repent.....

Exodus 32: 1-34

Now when the people saw that Moses delayed coming down from the mountain, they gathered together before Aaron and said to him, "Come, make us a god who will go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us up from the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him." So Aaron replied to them, "Take off the gold rings that are in the ears of your wives, your sons and daughters, and bring them to me." So all the people took off the gold rings that were in their ears and brought them to Aaron. And he took the gold from their hands, and fashioned it with an engraving tool and made it into a molten calf; and they said, "This is your god, O Israel, who brought you up from the land of Egypt." Now when Aaron saw the molten calf, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made a proclamation, and

said, "Tomorrow shall be a feast to the Lord!" ⁶ So they got up early the next day and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; then the people sat down to eat and drink, and got up to play [shamefully—without moral restraint].

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Go down at once, for your people, whom you brought up from the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves. ⁸ They have quickly turned aside from the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molten calf, and have worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, 'This is your god, O Israel, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!'" ⁹ The Lord said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and behold, they are a stiff-necked (stubborn, rebellious) people. ¹⁰ Now therefore, let Me alone and do not interfere, so that My anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them; and I will make of you (your descendants) a great nation."

Moses' Entreaty

¹¹ But Moses appeased and entreated the Lord his God, and said, "Lord, why does Your anger burn against Your people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand? ¹² Why should the Egyptians say, 'With evil [intent] their God brought them out to kill them in the mountains and destroy them from the face of the earth'? Turn away from Your burning anger and change Your mind about harming Your people.

¹³ Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel (Jacob), Your servants to whom You swore [an oath] by Yourself, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heavens, and all this land of which I have spoken I will give to your descendants, and they shall inherit it forever."

¹⁴ So the Lord changed His mind about the harm which He had said He would do to His people.

15 Then Moses turned and went down from the mountain with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hand; tablets that were written on both sides

—they were written on one side and on the other. ¹⁶ The tablets were the work of God; the writing was the writing of God engraved on the tablets.

¹⁷ Now when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said to Moses, "There is a sound of battle in the camp." ¹⁸ But Moses said, "It is not the sound of the cry of victory, No is it the sound of the cry of defeat; But I hear the sound of singing."

Moses' Anger

 19 And as soon as he approached the camp and he saw the calf and the dancing, Moses' anger burned; and he threw the tablets from his hands and smashed them at the foot of the mountain. 20 Then Moses took the calf they

had made and burned it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and scattered it on the surface of the water and made the Israelites drink it.

²¹ Then Moses said to Aaron, "What did this people do to you, that you have brought so great a sin on them?" ²² Aaron said, "Do not let the anger of my lord burn; you know the people yourself, that they are prone to evil. ²³ For they said to me, 'Make us a god who will go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.' ²⁴ I said to them, 'Let whoever has gold [jewelry], take it off.' So they gave it to me; then I threw it into the fire, and out came this calf."

Now when Moses saw that the people were out of control—for Aaron had let them get out of control to the point of being an object of mockery among their enemies— ²⁶ then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, "Whoever is on the Lord's side, come to me!" And all the sons of Levi [the priestly tribe] gathered together to him. ²⁷ He said to them, "Thus says the Lord God of Israel, 'Every man strap his sword on his thigh and go back and forth from gate to gate throughout the camp, and every man kill his brother, and every man his friend, and every man his neighbor [all who continue pagan worship]." ²⁸ So the sons of Levi did as Moses instructed, and about three thousand men of the people [of Israel] were killed that day. ²⁹ Then Moses said [to the Levites], "Dedicate yourselves today to the Lord—for each man has been against his own son and his own brother [in his attempt to escape execution]—so that He may restore and bestow His blessing on you this day."

Then the next day Moses said to the people, "You have committed a great sin. Now I will go up to the Lord; perhaps I can make atonement for your sin." ³¹ So Moses returned to the Lord, and said, "Oh, these people have committed a great sin [against You], and have made themselves a god of gold. ³² Yet now, if You will, forgive their sin—and if not, please blot me out of Your book which You have written (kill me)!" ³³ But the Lord said to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot him out of My book [not you]. ³⁴ But now go, lead the people [to the place] where I have told you. Behold, My Angel shall go before you; nevertheless, in the day when I punish, I will punish them for their sin!" ³⁵ So the Lord struck the people with a plague, because of what they had done with the calf which Aaron had made [for them].

Tammuz 3: June 15, 2018
Exodus 33: 1-11 (AMP)

The Journey Resumed

33 The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Depart, go up from here, you and the people whom you have brought from the land of Egypt, to the land which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel), saying, 'To your descendants I will give it.' ² I will send an Angel before you and I will drive out the Canaanite, the Amorite, the Hittite, the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite. ³ Go up to a land [of abundance] flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, because you are a stiff-necked (stubborn, rebellious) people, and I might destroy you on the way."

⁴ When the people heard this sad word, they mourned, and none of them put on his ornaments. ⁵ For the Lord had said to Moses, "Say to the sons of Israel, 'You are a stiff-necked (stubborn, rebellious) people! If I should come among you for one moment, I would destroy you. Now therefore, [penitently] take off your ornaments, so that I may know what to do with you." ⁶ So the Israelites left off all their ornaments [in repentance], from Mount Horeb (Sinai) onward.

Now Moses used to take his own tent and pitch it outside the camp, far away from the camp, and he called it the tent of meeting [of God with His own people]. And everyone who sought the Lord would go out to the [temporary] tent of meeting which was outside the camp. ⁸ Whenever Moses went out to the tent, all the people would rise and stand, each at his tent door, and look at Moses until he entered the tent. ⁹ Whenever Moses entered the tent, the pillar of cloud would descend and stand at the doorway of the tent; and the Lord would speak with Moses. ¹⁰ When all the people saw the pillar of cloud standing at the tent door, all the people would rise and worship, each at his tent door. ¹¹ And so the Lord used to speak to Moses face to face, just as a man speaks to his friend. When Moses returned to the camp, his attendant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, would not depart from the tent.

Tammuz 4: June 16, 2018 (Shabbat)

Exodus 33: 12-23 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Moses Intercedes

¹² Moses said to the Lord, "See, You say to me, 'Bring up this people,' but You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in My sight.' ¹³ Now therefore, I pray you, if I have found favor in Your sight, let me know Your

ways so that I may know You [becoming more deeply and intimately acquainted with You, recognizing and understanding Your ways more clearly] and that I may find grace and favor in Your sight. And consider also, that this nation is Your people." ¹⁴ And the Lord said, "My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest [by bringing you and the people into the promised land]." ¹⁵ And Moses said to Him, "If Your presence does not go [with me], do not lead us up from here. ¹⁶ For how then can it be known that Your people and I have found favor in Your sight? Is it not by Your going with us, so that we are distinguished, Your people and I, from all the [other] people on the face of the earth?"

¹⁷ The Lord said to Moses, "I will also do this thing that you have asked; for you have found favor (lovingkindness, mercy) in My sight and I have known you [personally] by name." ¹⁸ Then Moses said, "Please, show me Your glory!" ¹⁹ And God said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the Name of the Lord before you; for I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show compassion (lovingkindness) on whom I will show compassion." ²⁰ But He said, "You cannot see My face, for no man shall see Me and live!" ²¹ Then the Lord said, "Behold, there is a place beside Me, and you shall stand there on the rock; ²² and while My glory is passing by, I will put you in a cleft of the rock and protectively cover you with My hand until I have passed by. ²³ Then I will take away My hand and you shall see My back; but My face shall not be seen."

Tammuz 5: June 17, 2018 (Sunday) Exodus 34: 1-9 (AMP)

The Two Tablets Replaced

34 Then the Lord said to Moses, "Cut two tablets of stone like the first, and I will write on these tablets the words that were on the first tablets which you smashed [when you learned of Israel's idolatry]. ² So be ready by morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to Me on the top of the mountain. ³ No man is to come up with you, nor let any man be seen anywhere on the mountain; nor let flocks or herds feed in front of that mountain." ⁴ So Moses cut two tablets of stone like the first ones, and he got up early in the morning and went up on Mount Sinai, as the Lord had commanded him, and took the two tablets of stone in his hand. ⁵ Then the Lord descended in the cloud and stood there with Moses as he proclaimed the Name of the Lord. ⁶ Then the Lord passed by in front of him, and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth (faithfulness); ⁷ keeping

mercy and lovingkindness for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin; but He will by no means leave the guilty unpunished, visiting (avenging) the iniquity (sin, guilt) of the fathers upon the children and the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations [that is, calling the children to account for the sins of their fathers]." ⁸ Moses bowed to the earth immediately and worshiped [the Lord]. ⁹ And he said, "If now I have found favor and lovingkindness in Your sight, O Lord, let the Lord, please, go in our midst, though it is a stiff-necked (stubborn, rebellious) people, and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us as Your possession."

Tammuz 6: June 18, 2018 Exodus 34: 10-27

The Covenant Renewed

- ¹⁰ Then God said, "Behold, I am going to make a covenant. Before all your people I will do wondrous works (miracles) such as have not been created or produced in all the earth nor among any of the nations; and all the people among whom you live shall see the working of the Lord, for it is a fearful and awesome thing that I am going to do with you.
- ¹¹ "Be sure to observe what I am commanding you this day: behold, I am going to drive out the Amorite before you, and the Canaanite, the Hittite, the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite. ¹² Watch yourself so that you do not make a covenant (solemn agreement, treaty) with the inhabitants of the land into which you are going, or it will become a [dangerous] trap among you. ¹³ But you shall tear down and destroy their [pagan] altars, smash in pieces their [sacred] pillars (obelisks, images) and cut down their Asherim ¹⁴ —for you shall not worship any other god; for the Lord, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous (impassioned) God [demanding what is rightfully and uniquely His] $-\,^{15}$ otherwise you might make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land and they would play the prostitute with their gods and sacrifice to their gods, and someone might invite you to eat his sacrifice (meal), ¹⁶ and you might take some of his daughters for your sons, and his daughters would play the prostitute with their gods and cause your sons also to play the prostitute (commit apostasy) with their gods [that is, abandon the true God for manmade idols¹⁷ You shall make for vourselves no molten gods.
- 18 "You shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread (Passover). For seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, as I have commanded you, at the appointed time in the month of Abib; for in the month of Abib you came out of Egypt.

- ¹⁹ "All the firstborn males among your livestock belong to Me, whether cattle or sheep. ²⁰ You shall redeem the firstborn of a donkey with a lamb; but if you do not redeem it, then you shall break its neck. You shall redeem all the firstborn of your sons. None of you are to appear before Me emptyhanded.
- ²¹ "You shall work for six days, but on the seventh day you shall rest; [even] in plowing time and in harvest you shall rest [on the Sabbath]. ²² You shall observe and celebrate the Feast of Weeks (Harvest, First Fruits, or Pentecost), the first fruits of the wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering (Booths or Tabernacles) at the year's end. ²³ Three times a year all your males shall appear before the Lord God, the God of Israel. ²⁴ For I will drive out and dispossess nations before you and enlarge your borders; nor shall any man covet (actively seek for himself) your land when you go up to appear before the Lord your God three times a year.
- ²⁵ "You shall not offer the blood of My sacrifice with leavened bread, nor shall the sacrifice of the Feast of the Passover (Unleavened Bread) be left over until morning.
- ²⁶ "You shall bring the very first of the first fruits of your ground to the house of the Lord your God.

"You shall not boil a young goat in his mother's milk [as some pagans do]."

²⁷ Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write these words, for in accordance with these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel." ²⁸ Moses was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights; he ate no bread and drank no water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments. God wrote it the first time, Moses had to write it the second time.

Tammuz 7: June 19, 2018 Exodus 35:20-35

Gifts Received

²⁰ Then all the congregation of the Israelites left Moses' presence.

²¹ Everyone whose heart stirred him and everyone whose spirit moved him came and brought the Lord's offering to be used for the Tent of Meeting, for all its service, and for the holy garments. ²² Then all whose hearts moved them, both men and women, came and brought brooches, earrings or nose rings, signet rings, and necklaces, all jewels of gold; everyone bringing an

offering of gold to the Lord. ²³ Every man who had in his possession blue or purple or scarlet fabric, and fine linen, and goats' hair, and rams' skins dyed red and porpoise skins, brought them. ²⁴ Everyone who could make an offering of silver or bronze brought it as the Lord's offering; every man who had in his possession acacia wood for any work of the service brought it. ²⁵ All the skilled and talented women spun thread with their hands, and brought what they had spun, blue and purple and scarlet fabric and fine linen. ²⁶ All the women whose heart stirred with a skill spun the goats' hair. ²⁷ The leaders brought onyx stones and other stones to be put in settings for the ephod and for the breastpiece, ²⁸ and spice and [olive] oil for the light and for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense. ²⁹ The Israelites, all the men and women whose heart moved them to bring material for all the work which the Lord had commanded through Moses to be done, brought a freewill (voluntary) offering to the Lord.

³⁰ Then Moses said to the Israelites, "See, the Lord called by name Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah; ³¹ and He has filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom and skill, with intelligence and understanding, and with knowledge in all [areas of] craftsmanship, ³² to devise artistic designs to work in gold, silver, and bronze, ³³ and in the cutting of stones for setting and in the carving of wood, for work in every skilled craft. ³⁴ He has also put in Bezalel's heart [the willingness] to teach [others the same skills], both he and Oholiab, son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. ³⁵ He has filled them with skill to do the work of an engraver, of a designer, and of an embroiderer, in blue, purple, and scarlet fabric, and in fine linen, and of a weaver; makers of every work and embroiderers of [excellent] designs.

Tammuz 7: June 20, 2018

Be like Moses: let GODS radiance shine upon you through Christ 2 Corinthians 3:13-18 Amplified Bible (AMP)

¹³ and we are not like Moses, who used to put a veil over his face so that the Israelites would not gaze at the end of the glory which was fading away. ¹⁴ But [in fact] their minds were hardened [for they had lost the ability to understand]; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the same veil remains unlifted, because it is removed [only] in Christ. ¹⁵ But to this day whenever Moses is read, a veil [of blindness] lies over their heart; ¹⁶ but whenever a person turns [in repentance and faith] to the Lord, the veil is taken away. ¹⁷ Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the

Lord is, there is liberty [emancipation from bondage, true freedom]. ¹⁸ And we all, with unveiled face, continually seeing as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are progressively being transformed into His image from [one degree of] glory to [even more] glory, which comes from the Lord, [who is] the Spirit.

Tammuz 9: June 21, 2018

THERE HAS BEEN AN ATTACK AGAINST MANY BUT THE TRUTH IS YOU ARE ENTERING YOUR GREATEST ADVENTURES WITH JESUS, YET!!! by Lana Vawser

I felt the wooing of the Lord recently, that He wanted to speak and release a declaration over His people for this season that we are in. Tammuz 13: June 25, 2018
"New Freedom, Authority and Alliances Are Coming"
Doug Addison, Los Angeles, CA

"'Yes indeed, it won't be long now.' God's Decree. 'Things are going to

happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won't be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings..." (Amos 9:13-15 MSG)

As hidden things are revealed, it will free you up both physically and spiritually. A new wind is coming to help you overcome the attacks that have held you back. Starting this month, God is releasing a backlog of unanswered prayer and blessings. The storehouses are beginning to open to prepare and align you for what is coming in September.

New Breakthrough Prayer

God is releasing new prayer strategies that will help you get your breakthrough. This is a time in which the Lord is going to reveal and heal things that have been holding on. God is going to reveal hidden plans the enemy has been using against you in the area of your destiny. This includes health, relationships and financial breakthroughs.

Many people have been in a time of limitation, trapped in a prison of sickness, fear and doubt. Now the Lord is issuing orders from Heaven to release you from these restraints. Some of these restraints came from previous seasons of your life that need to be removed. Others are from the attacks against your calling to be part of the coming revival. Satan has been working overtime trying to get you to quit. But if you're reading this, you have made it through the testing time.

There are three prisons the enemy has been trying to keep you trapped in—the prison of the past, the prison of pain and the prison of unforgiveness.

As you are released from these prisons, God is going to align you just as He said in Psalm 142:7, "Then ... the righteous will gather about me...." You can expect a sudden shift in relationships as God is going to realign you for the coming season.

Signet Ring of Authority

"'On that day,' declares the Lord Almighty, 'I will take you, My servant ...' declares the Lord, 'and I will make you like My signet ring, for I have chosen you,' declares the Lord Almighty.'" (Haggai 2:23 NIV)

In an encounter with the Lord, I saw Him giving signet rings of authority to people who have gone through the fire of testing. Many who received this new authority thought they had messed up or missed the Lord. But in reality, the Lord was using what looked like loss to prepare them.

God is placing these rings of authority on people right now, and the key to receiving it is in this prophetic word. You will need to ask the Lord to reveal and heal the areas where the enemy has been holding you back. You will need to discern any unholy alliances and reposition yourself, if necessary.

As you are released from the prison of your pain and past, the Lord will give you new authority to overcome the things that have overcome you.

This is a very encouraging and pivotal month for many people. Like I mentioned previously, this might not be for everyone just yet. But you can grab hold of it and ask the Lord to bring you these things.

Tammuz 14: June 26, 2018

Once again "Know Your Authority Over Darkness!

An Invitation to the Secret Place" John Belt, Cincinnati, OH

"Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways." (Psalm 91:9-11)

God invites us into His secret place to spend time with Him. It is the highest invitation of all with incomprehensible benefits for our lives. The Lord understands us better than we understand ourselves. The entire concept of promises is hinged on our response to His offer. God knows that we need benefits. "Bless the Lord, oh my soul, and forget not all of His benefits..." (Psalm 103:2).

It is natural for us to look for things that are beneficial to us. I don't think that's a bad thing, for God made us that way. When our hearts are given over to the Lord and His plans for us, He causes amazing favor to invade our lives. Just as a father gives his child reward, God is the ultimate rewarder as we seek Him. Jesus further clarifies this by telling us that if our earthly father, being evil, would give good gifts then how much more will the heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask (see Luke 11:13). God wants us to recognize Him as our source. He wants us completely dependent on Him. This is why He gives us promises so that He can show Himself faithful to us. He wants us to know just how good He is.

A Higher Place

The secret place has amazing benefits for us. Let's not forget His benefits (Psalm 103:2)! "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will abide under the shadow of the Almighty" (Psalm 91:1).

I love how this passage shows us that it is not just the secret place, but the secret place of the "Most High". God has so many names that describe who He is. In this verse He describes Himself as the "Most High". He is not the "Least High" or "Kind of High" but He is the "Highest of Highs"! He will make our feet like the feet of deer where we can ascend to His high places – where we can scale the mountains as His overcomers (see Psalm 18:33).

When you associate yourself with God you are connecting to Him who is the Most High, who is higher than the heavens, who has higher thoughts, higher plans and will help you to see things from His highest perspective.

"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

Tammuz 15: June 27, 2018

<u>2 Kings 8:1-6!</u> Favor is extended to you from another source! The King Restores the Shunammite's Land

8 Now Elisha had said to the [Shunammite] woman whose son he had restored to life, "Prepare and go, you and your household, and stay

temporarily wherever you can; for the Lord has called for a famine, and moreover, it will come on the land [and continue] for seven years." ² So the woman set out and did everything in accordance with the word of the man of God. She and her household went and stayed temporarily as foreigners in the land of the Philistines for seven years. ³ At the end of the seven years the woman returned from the land of the Philistines; and she went to appeal to the king [of Israel] for her house and for her land. ⁴ Now the king was talking with Gehazi, the servant of the man of God, saying, "Tell me all the great things that Elisha has done." ⁵ And [just] as Gehazi was telling the king how Elisha had restored the dead to life, behold, the woman whose son he had restored to life appealed to the king for her house and for her land. And Gehazi said, "My lord, O king, this is the woman and this is her son, whom Elisha restored to life." ⁶ When the king asked the woman, she told him [everything]. So the king appointed for her a certain high official, saying, "Restore everything that was hers, including all the produce of the field since the day that she left the land until now." What needs to be restored in your life?

Tammuz 16: June 28, 2018

Thank GOD for Grace!!! Read Ruth 2! Think of a time when favor was extended to you. Praise God for it for all have sinned seek HIM, repent and receive Grace!

Ruth 2: 1-23

Ruth Gleans in Boaz' Field: God is able to make a way!

2 Now Naomi had a relative of her husband, a man of great wealth and influence, from the family of Elimelech, whose name was Boaz. ² And Ruth the Moabitess said to Naomi, "Please let me go to the field and glean among the ears of grain after one [of the reapers] in whose sight I may find favor." Naomi said to her, "Go, my daughter." ³ So Ruth went and picked up the leftover grain in a field after the reapers; and she happened to stop at the plot of land belonging to Boaz, who was of the family of Elimelech. ⁴ It was then that Boaz came back from Bethlehem and said to the reapers, "The Lord be with you!" And they answered him, "The Lord bless you!" ⁵ Then Boaz said to his servant who was in charge of the reapers, "Whose young woman is this?" ⁶ The servant in charge of the reapers answered, "She is the young Moabite woman who came back with Naomi from the country of Moab. ⁷ And she said, 'Please let me glean and gather after the reapers among the sheaves.' So she came and has continued [gathering grain] from early morning until now, except when she sat [resting] for a little while in the

[field] house."

⁸ Then Boaz said to Ruth, "Listen carefully, my daughter. Do not go to glean in another field or leave this one, but stay here close by my maids. ⁹ Watch which field they reap, and follow behind them. I have commanded the servants not to touch you. And when you are thirsty, go to the [water] jars and drink from what the servants draw." ¹⁰ Then she kneeled face downward, bowing to the ground, and said to him, "Why have I found favor in your eyes that you should notice me, when I am a foreigner?" ¹¹ Boaz answered her, "I have been made fully aware of everything that you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband, and how you have left your father and mother and the land of your birth, and have come to a people that you did not know before. ¹² May the Lord repay you for your kindness, and may your reward be full from the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge." ¹³ Then she said, "Let me find favor in your sight, my lord, for you have comforted me and have spoken kindly to your maidservant, though I am not as one of your maidservants."

¹⁴ At mealtime Boaz said to her, "Come over here and eat some bread and dip your bread in the vinegar." So she sat beside the reapers; and he served her roasted grain, and she ate until she was satisfied and she had some left [for Naomi]. ¹⁵ When she got up to glean, Boaz ordered his servants, "Let her glean even among the sheaves, and do not insult her. ¹⁶ Also you shall purposely pull out for her some stalks [of grain] from the sheaves and leave them so that she may collect them, and do not rebuke her."

17 So she gleaned in the field until evening. Then she beat out what she had gleaned, and it was about an ephah of barley. 18 She picked it up and went into the city, and her mother-in-law saw what she had gleaned. Ruth also took out and gave to Naomi what she had saved after she [had eaten and] was satisfied. 19 Her mother-in-law said to her, "Where did you glean today? Where did you work? Blessed be the man who took notice of you." So she told her mother-in-law with whom she had worked and said, "The name of the man with whom I worked today is Boaz." 20 Naomi said to her daughter-in-law, "May he be blessed of the Lord who has not ceased His kindness to the living and to the dead." Again Naomi said to her, "The man is one of our closest relatives, one who has the right to redeem us." 21 Then Ruth the Moabitess said, "He also said to me, 'Stay close to my servants until they have harvested my entire crop." 22 Naomi said to Ruth, "It is good, my daughter, for you to go out [to work] with his maids, so that others do not

assault you in another field." ²³ So she stayed close to the maids of Boaz, gleaning until the end of the barley and wheat harvests.

Tammuz 17: June 29, 2018 Revelation 2: 2-7 (AMP)

Message to Ephesus; Favor by overcoming

2 "To the angel (divine messenger) of the church in Ephesus write:

"These are the words of the One who holds [firmly] the seven stars [which are the angels or messengers of the seven churches] in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands (the seven churches):

² 'I know your deeds and your toil, and your patient endurance, and that you cannot tolerate those who are evil, and have tested and critically appraised those who call themselves apostles (special messengers, personally chosen representatives, of Christ), and [in fact] are not, and have found them to be liars and impostors; ³ and [I know that] you [who believe] are enduring patiently and are bearing up for My name's sake, and that you have not grown weary [of being faithful to the truth]. ⁴ But I have this [charge] against you, that you have left your first love [you have lost the depth of love that you first had for Me1. ⁵ So remember the heights from which you have fallen, and repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, your sinful behavior—seek God's will] and do the works you did at first [when you first knew Me]; otherwise, I will visit you and remove your lampstand (the church, its impact) from its place—unless you repent. ⁶ Yet you have this [to your credit], that you hate the works and corrupt teachings of the Nicolaitans [that mislead and delude the people], which I also hate. ⁷ He who has an ear, let him hear and heed what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes [the world through believing that Jesus is the Son of God], I will grant [the privilege] to eat [the fruit] from the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God.'

Revelation 2:26-29

And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star.

Message to Laodicea

¹⁴ "To the angel (divine messenger) of the church in Laodicea write: "These are the words of the Amen, the trusted and faithful and true Witness, the Beginning and Origin of God's creation:

15 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold (invigorating, refreshing) nor hot (healing, therapeutic); I wish that you were [d]cold or hot. 16 So because you are lukewarm (spiritually useless), and neither hot nor cold, I will vomit you out of My mouth [rejecting you with disgust]. 17 Because you say, "I am rich, and have prospered and grown wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked [without hope and in great need], 18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold that has been heated red hot and refined by fire so that you may become truly rich; and white clothes [representing righteousness] to clothe yourself so that the shame of your nakedness will not be seen; and healing salve to put on your eyes so that you may see. 19 Those whom I

Tammuz 20: July 2, 2018 Ephesians 1:19-23

And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Read Zechariah 3 and 4. Decree that the Lord is re-clothing you with a new identity. Shout grace to the mountains that stopped you from advancing in the last season and go into the new clothed with righteousness.

Zechariah 3 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Joshua, the High Priest

3 Then the guiding angel showed me Joshua the high priest [representing disobedient, sinful Israel] standing before the Angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at Joshua's right hand to be his adversary and to accuse him. ² And the Lord said to Satan, "The Lord rebuke you, Satan! Even the Lord, who [now and ever] has chosen Jerusalem, rebuke you! Is this not a log snatched and rescued from the fire?" ³ Now Joshua was clothed with filthy (nauseatingly vile) garments and was standing before the Angel [of the Lord]. ⁴ He spoke to those who stood before Him, saying, "Remove the filthy garments from him." Tammuz 21: July 3, 2018

Isaiah 6:1-8

It was in the year King Uzziah died that I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. ² Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. They were calling out to each other,

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies! The whole earth is filled with his glory!"

Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke. Then I said, "It's all over! I am doomed, for I am a sinful man. I have filthy lips, and I live among a people with filthy lips. Yet I have seen the King, the Lord of Heaven's Armies." Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal he had taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. He touched my lips with it and said, "See, this coal has touched your lips. Now your guilt is removed, and your sins are forgiven."

Isaiah's Commission

Revelation 4 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Scene in Heaven

4 After this I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven! And the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a [war] trumpet speaking with me, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things." ² At once I was in [special communication with] the Spirit; and behold, a throne stood in heaven, with One seated on the throne.

3 And He who sat there appeared like [the crystalline sparkle of] jasper stone and [the fiery redness of] a sardius stone, and encircling the throne there was a rainbow that looked like [the color of an] emerald. ⁴ Twenty-four [other] thrones surrounded the throne; and seated on these thrones were twenty-four elders dressed in white clothing, with crowns of gold on their heads.

The Throne and Worship of the Creator

⁵ From the throne came flashes of lightning and [rumbling] sounds and peals of thunder. Seven lamps of fire were burning in front of the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God; ⁶ and in front of the throne there was something like a sea or large expanse of glass, like [the clearest] crystal. In the center and around the throne were four living creatures who were full of eyes in front and behind [seeing everything and knowing everything that is around them]. ⁷ The first living creature was like a lion, the second creature like a calf (ox), the third creature had the face of a man, and the fourth creature was like a flying eagle. ⁸ And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes all over and within [underneath their wings]; and day and night they never stop saying,

"Holy, holy, holy [is the] Lord God, the Almighty [the Omnipotent, the Ruler of all], who was and who is and who is to come [the unchanging, eternal God]."

 9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanksgiving to Him who sits on the throne, to Him who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne, and they worship Him who lives forever and ever; and they throw down their crowns before the throne, saying,

¹¹ "Worthy are You, our Lord and God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they exist, and were created and brought into being."

Tammuz 23: July 5, 2018

Read Acts 6:8. [Stephen Is Arrested] Stephen, a man full of God's grace and power,

performed amazing miracles and signs among the people.

Acts 6:8-15 Amplified Bible (AMP)

⁸ Now Stephen, full of grace (divine blessing, favor) and power, was doing great wonders and signs (attesting miracles) among the people. ⁹ However, some men from what was called the Synagogue of the Freedmen (freed Jewish slaves), both Cyrenians and Alexandrians, and some from Cilicia and [the province of] Asia, rose up and questioned and argued with Stephen. 10 But they were not able to successfully withstand and cope with the wisdom and the intelligence [and the power and inspiration] of the Spirit by whom he was speaking. ¹¹ Then [to attack him another way] they secretly instructed men to say, "We have heard this man [Stephen] speak blasphemous (slanderous, sacrilegious, abusive) words against Moses and against God." ¹² And they provoked and incited the people, as well as the elders and the scribes, and they came up to Stephen and seized him and brought him before the Council (Sanhedrin, Jewish High Court). ¹³ They presented false witnesses who said, "This man never stops speaking against this holy place and the Law [of Moses]; ¹⁴ for we have heard him say that this Jesus the Nazarene will tear down this place and will change the traditions and customs which Moses handed down to us." ¹⁵ Then all those who were sitting in the Council, stared [intently] at him, and they saw that Stephen's face was like the face of an angel.

Tammuz 24: July 6, 2018 <u>Acts 7: 51-60 (AMP)</u>

⁵¹ "You stiff-necked and stubborn people, uncircumcised in heart and ears, you are always actively resisting the Holy Spirit. You are doing just as your fathers did. ⁵² Which one of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? They killed those who proclaimed beforehand the coming of the Righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers you have now become; ⁵³ you who received the law as ordained and delivered to you by angels, and yet you did not obey it!"

Stephen Put to Death

Now when they heard this [accusation and understood its implication], they were cut to the heart, and they began grinding their teeth [in rage] at him. ⁵⁵ But he, being full of the Holy Spirit and led by Him, gazed into heaven and saw the glory [the great splendor and majesty] of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God; ⁵⁶ and he said, "Look! I see the heavens opened up [in welcome] and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!" ⁵⁷ But they shouted with loud voices, and covered their ears and

together rushed at him [considering him guilty of blasphemy]. ⁵⁸ Then they drove him out of the city and began stoning him; and the witnesses placed their outer robes at the feet of a young man named Saul. ⁵⁹ They continued stoning Stephen as he called on the Lord and said, "Lord Jesus, receive and accept and welcome my spirit!" ⁶⁰ Then falling on his knees [in worship], he cried out loudly, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them [do not charge them]!" When he had said this, he fell asleep [in death].

Tammuz 25: July 7, 2018 Revelation 5 Amplified Bible (AMP)

The Scroll with Seven Seals

5 I saw in the right hand of Him who was seated on the throne a scroll written on the inside and on the back, closed and sealed with seven seals.

² And I saw a strong angel announcing with a loud voice, "Who is worthy [having the authority and virtue] to open the scroll and to break its seals?"

³ And no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth [in Hades, the realm of the dead] was able to open the scroll or look into it. ⁴ And I began to weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or look into it.

⁵ Then one of the [twenty-four] elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look closely, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome and conquered! He can open the scroll and [break] its seven seals."

⁶ And there between the throne (with the four living creatures) and among the elders I saw a Lamb (Christ) standing, [bearing scars and wounds] as though it had been slain, with seven horns (complete power) and with seven eyes (complete knowledge), which are the seven Spirits of God who have been sent [on duty] into all the earth. ⁷ And He came and took the scroll from the right hand of Him who sat on the throne. ⁸ And when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb (Christ), each one holding a harp and golden bowls full of fragrant incense, which are the prayers of the saints (God's people). ⁹ And they sang a new song [of glorious redemption], saying,

"Worthy and deserving are You to take the scroll and to break its seals; for You were slain (sacrificed), and with Your blood You purchased people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

¹⁰ "You have made them to be a kingdom [of royal subjects] and priests to our God; and they will reign on the earth."

Angels Exalt the Lamb

¹¹ Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and [the voice] of the living creatures and the elders; and they numbered myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands (innumerable), ¹² saying in a loud voice,

"Worthy and deserving is the Lamb that was sacrificed to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing."

¹³ And I heard every created thing that is in heaven or on earth or under the earth [in Hades, the realm of the dead] or on the sea, and everything that is in them, saying [together],

"To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb (Christ), be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever."

¹⁴ And the four living creatures kept saying, "Amen." And the elders fell down and worshiped [Him who lives forever and ever].

Tammuz 26: July 8, 2018 Revelation 11:15-19 Amplified Bible (AMP)

The Seventh Trumpet—Christ's Reign Foreseen

¹⁵ Then the seventh angel sounded [his trumpet]; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

"The kingdom (dominion, rule) of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." 16 And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell face downward and worshiped God, 17 saying,

"To You we give thanks, O Lord God Almighty [the Omnipotent, the Ruler of all], Who are and Who were, because You have taken Your great power and the sovereignty [which is rightly Yours] and have [now] begun to reign.

¹⁸ And the nations (Gentiles) became enraged, and Your wrath and indignation came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and [the time came] to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints (God's people) and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and [the time came] to destroy the destroyers of the earth."

19 And the temple of God which is in heaven was opened; and the ark of His

covenant appeared in His temple, and there were flashes of lightning, loud rumblings and peals of thunder and an earthquake and a great hailstorm.

Tammuz 27: July 9 2018 <u>Revelation 14:6-13 (AMP)</u>

The Angel with the Gospel

⁶ Then I saw another angel flying in mid-heaven, with an eternal gospel to preach to the inhabitants of the earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people; ⁷ and he said with a loud voice, "Fear God [with awe and reverence], and give Him glory [and honor and praise in worship], because the hour of His judgment has come; [with all your heart] worship Him who created the heaven and the earth, the sea and the springs of water."

Doom for Proud Babylon

⁸ Then another angel, a second one, followed, saying, "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who has made all nations drink the wine of the passion of her immorality [corrupting them with idolatry]."

Doom for Worshipers of the Beast

⁹ Then another angel, a third one, followed them, saying with a loud voice, "Whoever worships the beast and his image and receives the mark [of the beast] on his forehead or on his hand, ¹⁰ he too will [have to] drink of the wine of the wrath of God, mixed undiluted into the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone (flaming sulfur) in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb (Christ). ¹¹ And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day and night—those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." ¹² Here is [encouragement for] the steadfast endurance of the saints (God's people), those who habitually keep God's commandments and their faith in Jesus.

Tammuz 28: July 10, 2018
Revelation 19:1-10 (AMP)

¹³ Then I heard [the distinct words of] a voice from heaven, saying, "Write, 'Blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired) are the dead who die in the Lord from now on!" "Yes, [blessed indeed]," says the Spirit, "so that they may rest and have relief from their labors, for their deeds do follow them."

The Fourfold Hallelujah

19 After these things I heard something like the great and mighty shout of a vast multitude in heaven, exclaiming,

"Hallelujah! Salvation and glory (splendor, majesty) and power (dominion, might) belong to our God; ² because His judgments are true and righteous. He has judged [convicted and pronounced sentence on] the great prostitute (idolatress) who was corrupting and ruining and poisoning the earth with her adultery (idolatry), and He has imposed the penalty for the blood of His bond-servants on her." ³ And a second time they said, "Hallelujah! Her smoke shall ascend forever and ever." ⁴ Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures also fell down and worshiped God who sits on the throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah (praise the Lord)!" ⁵ Then from the throne there came a voice, saying,

"Praise our God, all you bond-servants of His, you who fear Him, the small (common) and the great (distinguished)."

Marriage of the Lamb

⁶ Then I heard something like the shout of a vast multitude, and like the boom of many pounding waves, and like the roar of mighty peals of thunder, saying,

"Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, [the Omnipotent, the Ruler of all] reigns.

⁷ Let us rejoice and shout for joy! Let us give Him glory and honor, for the marriage of the Lamb has come [at last] and His bride (the redeemed) has prepared herself." ⁸ She has been permitted to dress in fine linen, dazzling white and clean—for the fine linen signifies the righteous acts of the saints [the ethical conduct, personal integrity, moral courage, and godly character of believers].

⁹ Then the angel said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me [further], "These are the true and exact words of God." ¹⁰ Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he [stopped me and] said to me, "You must not do that; I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers and sisters who have and hold the testimony of Jesus. Worship God [alone]. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy [His life and teaching are the heart of prophecy]."

Tammuz 29: July 11, 2018

Revelation 19:11-16 Amplified Bible (AMP)

The Coming of Christ the Conqueror

¹¹ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who was riding it is called Faithful and True (trustworthy, loyal, incorruptible, steady), and in righteousness He judges and wages war [on the rebellious nations]. ¹² His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many royal crowns; and He has a name inscribed [on Him] which no one knows or understands except Himself. ¹³ He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. ¹⁴ And the armies of heaven, dressed in fine linen, [dazzling] white and clean, followed Him on white horses. ¹⁵ From His mouth comes a sharp sword (His word) with which He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He will tread the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty [in judgment of the rebellious world]. ¹⁶ And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name inscribed, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."

Tammuz 30: July 12, 2018

Revelation 22:7-21 Amplified Bible (AMP)

- ⁷ "And behold, I am coming quickly. Blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired) is the one who heeds and takes to heart and remembers the words of the prophecy [that is, the predictions, consolations, and warnings] contained in this book (scroll)."
- ⁸ I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. ⁹ But he said to me, "Do not do that. I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets and with those who heed and remember [the truths contained in] the words of this book. Worship God."
- ¹⁰ And he said to me, "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time [of their fulfillment] is near. ¹¹ Let the one who does wrong, still do wrong; and the one who is filthy (vile, impure), still be filthy; and the one who is righteous (just, upright), still be righteous; and the one who is holy, still be holy."
- ¹² "Behold, I (Jesus) am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to each one according to the merit of his deeds (earthly works, faithfulness).
 ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End [the Eternal One]."

Blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired) are those who wash their robes [in the blood of Christ by believing and trusting in Him—the righteous who do His commandments], so that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter by the gates into the city. ¹⁵ Outside are the dogs [the godless, the impure, those of low moral character] and the sorcerers [with their intoxicating drugs, and magic arts], and the immoral persons [the perverted, the molesters, and the adulterers], and the murderers, and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying (deception, cheating).

The Final Invitation

- ¹⁶ "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you and to give you assurance of these things for the churches. I am the Root (the Source, the Life) and the Offspring of David, the radiant and bright Morning Star."
- ¹⁷ The [Holy] Spirit and the bride (the church, believers) say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who wishes take and drink the water of life without cost.
- ¹⁸ I testify and warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book [its predictions, consolations, and admonitions]: if anyone adds [anything] to them, God will add to him the plagues (afflictions, calamities) which are written in this book; ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from or distorts the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away [from that one] his share from the tree of life and from the holy city (new Jerusalem), which are written in this book.
- ²⁰ He who testifies and affirms these things says, "Yes, I am coming quickly." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.
- ²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus (the Christ, the Messiah) be with all [the saints—all believers, those set apart for God]. Amen.
