The Amplified, King James, New American Standard and Passion versions of the WORD of GOD were used in this study. Biblical Months fall under the Law Form of YHWH (Yahweh), Father-Son-Holy Spirit, through the revelation of His Word.

I often ask myself, do the readers understand how to pray after reading a text of prophesy. The answer is to ask the LORD how did this relates in the bible for then and how does it relate now? How would YOU have me to pray Lord?

In developing this calendar prayer guide prophets are used to bring current words from the LORD*. (See last page.) Many Christians do not have access to publications such as the Elijah List, Judaism 101, teachings from Chuck Pierce, Robert Heidler and many other contributing authors which are included.* 1 Thessalonians 5:20 Do not spurn the gifts and utterances of the prophets (do not depreciate prophetic revelations) nor despise inspired instruction or exhortation or warning.

It's been two years since we started publishing the Republic Prayer Calendar based on the Hebrew Lunar Cycle so for anyone joining us for the first time I want to give some background. In Genisus1:1 the very first words GOD speaks is "In the beginning" and according to Rabbinical teaching, the very first commandment given to the children of Israel while in Egypt was to sanctify the "New Moon". From that point on the nation of GOD was to look at the Moon for the setting of their days and evenings and as a means to reconcile the times and seasons. The Biblical day begins at sundown, and ends at sundown the following day. At sundown, it is known as the dawning of a new day.

<u>Genesis 1:5</u>, And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day. Even history is set into motion as God said that the world may be understood as seven 1,000 days with the last 7th, 1,000 year of days would be the time being the Millennial Reign of Christ.

The Lunar cycle has only 29.5 days or 354 days per year whereas the solar cycle has 365 days per year. An additional month is added every 3rd year to coordinate with the solar calendar for agricultural seasons. The reason the numerical date may not look like the previous years is because of this shift. The Month begins with the rising of the "New

Moon". The Hebrew year begins in spring every year in the Month of Nissan when Passover occurs. Every month is related to a specific tribe, feast and season.

As we begin the month of Sivan keep in mind that man changed the calendar, GOD didn't.

The church today misses a very important part of their history and understanding. There was never really a new church started. They worshipped and practiced Hebrew. The difference was Christ completed the requirements of the Law and made us "New Men" in Him. If you think about it we are literally Hebrew as we were adopted or grafted in to the Kingdom.


With that in mind we will not miss out on what God is doing by honoring the feast or HIS Calendar. At the same time we will honor our Lord Yeshua the Christ and we may learn something.

The Biblical Month of Sivan*, begins this year at sundown on June 4th – July 3rd 2019

*Sivan means in Hebrew – "Their Covering"

Month of Sivan (May/June)/Linked with the Tribe of Zebulun which means "habitation". This was the month of giving of the Torah (the Laws of life) and giving back to GOD through our sacrifices and offerings. It is the businessman's month, and the month of alignment with the Holy Spirit, it is a time to set our boundaries and align with our walk for the future, Exodus 20-26 and Acts 2. Therefor we get, "The Covering of Their Habitation".

We are praying for our nation and the LAND as you pray each day. Please consider including these scriptures in those prayers and make request out of each. Example: Father, You have said that that you desire not the offerings of grain and lambs, but the sacrifice of obedience through Your Word. We offer up Your Word as we pray for our nation, our leadership and our people.



Tribe: Zebulun

The tribe of Zebulun shared a special bond with the tribe of Issachar. They were born one after another to their mother, Leah. In the Land of Israel, they inherited lands that were adjacent, and temporally, they correspond to the two months Iyar and Sivan that follow one another. But, the heart of their bond was in their agreement to support one another. Issachar was a tribe of scholars who excelled in Torah study. Zebulun was a tribe of successful merchants and seafarers. They agreed to split their material and spiritual wealth equally.

As such, we might expect that Issachar would correspond to the month of Sivan, in which the Torah was given and Zebulun to the month of Iyar. But, one of the analytic principles of Kabbalah is that the cause is inherently higher than the effect which it causes. Since, at the basic level, Zebulun's willingness to split their material wealth allowed Issachar to devote themselves to the Torah; it is Zebulun that corresponds to Sivan and the giving of the Torah. Zebulun's material sacrifices are what sustain the Torah and therefore, in the end the Torah is in their merit.

Indeed, the Arizal explains that the origin of the soul of Zebulun is in the *sefirah* of crown, above the *sefirah* of wisdom, which is the origin of Issachar's soul.

This fact further ties the tribe of Zebulun with the month of Sivan. In spite of their bond with their brethren in Issachar, the Jews of the tribe of Zebulun had to study Torah for themselves too. Since their soul-root is in crown, the Torah that they were particularly connected to is also at the level of crown. This is especially relevant to the giving of the Torah at Mt. Sinai, because the particular level revealed then, the Ten Commandments, is related to the *sefirah* of crown. As noted, the *gematria* of crown is 620, the number of letters in the Ten Commandments.

Essence of Sivan

This "Essence" is taken from the Sourcebook for Leaders, written by Rabbi Rachel Gartner and Barbara Berley Melits, for <u>Rosh Hodesh</u>: It's a Girl Thing! This experiential program was created by Kolot: The Center for Jewish Women's and Gender Studies to strengthen the Jewish identity and self-esteem of adolescent girls through monthly celebrations of the New Moon festival. The program is now available through <u>Moving Traditions</u>.



God the Father called Moses to come upon the mountain to receive the Torah.

Sivan is the third of the twelve months of the Jewish calendar. It is the month in which God descended on Mt. Sinai and gave the Torah to the Jewish people. As noted elsewhere, there are only three months that are referred in the Torah in conjunction with the exodus from Egypt: Nisan, Iyar, and Sivan,¹

The Third Month

In the third month of the exodus from Egypt, they came to the Sinai desert.²

All the prophets begin their prophecies with the word "So [says the Almighty...]" above and beyond them is Moses who begins with the word "This [is what the Almighty says]." 14

Fast Facts

Tradition teaches that it was on Rosh Hodesh Sivan that the Israelites "camped at the foot of <u>Sinai</u>" in preparation to receive the <u>Torah</u> (Exodus 19:6). The verb used for "camped" in Exodus 19:6 is in the singular. It is taught that at the moment the Israelites determined to receive the Torah, they were united in heart and mind like a single person. Sivan's symbol of the twins—two distinct human beings sharing one womb—can represent the harmony that comes when people <u>celebrate</u> their differences while coming together to work for a common, higher goal, such as receiving and following the Torah.

Gemini (Twins)

The Zodiac sign of the twins first and foremost alludes to the two identical Tablets of the Covenant given to Moses at Mt. Sinai.

When a bride and groom attain the highest degree of connection, they are described as twins. The day on which God gave the Torah to the Jewish people is described as a wedding between the two. In the Song of Songs, ¹⁸ God refers to His bride, the Jewish people, as perfect. The sages read this word as "twin").

In the Torah the twins are referred to as Jacob and Esau.

Romans 9:13 As it is written and forever remains written, "Jacob I loved (chose, protected, blessed), but Esau I hated (held in disregard compared to Jacob)."



The archetypal twins in the Torah are Jacob and Esau. Far from being identical, Jacob and Esau represent spiritual opposites. In every Jew, Jacob represents the good inclination while Esau represents the evil inclination. Nonetheless, through the power of the Torah, given on the month of Sivan, even the relationship between these diametrically opposed twins can be rectified and the two can unite. For this reason, the Torah commands us, "You shall love God with all of your heart." The sages explain that "all of your heart" refers to both inclinations. Likewise, between the two Tablets of the Covenant, the right tablet—which contains the first 5 commandments—primarily addresses the good inclination (symbolized by Jacob) and the left tablet—containing the final 5 commandments, beginning with "You shall not murder," "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not steal"—primarily addresses the evil inclination (symbolized by Esau).

Shavuot Customs

Studying Torah all night long! It is a kabbalistic tradition (coming from the sixteenth-century mystics of Safed) to stay up the entire (first) night of Shavuot studying Torah. Known as <u>Tikkun Leil Shavuot</u>, this all-night study session is an opportunity to recommit ourselves to the study of Torah. Tradition teaches that the skies open up during this night for a brief moment, and God favorably answers all prayers. The kabbalists also think of Shavuot as the moment when God and Israel wed; the Torah is the *ketubah* (marriage contract) or written affirmation of the covenant between them.

Reading (The Book of Ruth): Our story begins in the Land of Israel, during the period of the rule of the Judges, leaders of the Jewish People who preceded the Kings. The first characters we encounter in this story are Elimelech, his wife Naomi, and their two sons, Machlon and Kilyon.

Elimelech, Naomi, and their family move to Moav in order to escape the effects of a famine that has broken out in the Land of Israel. Elimelech then dies, leaving Naomi alone with her two sons. As they grow up, each of her sons marries a Moabite woman. One marries Orpah, and the other marries Ruth. After ten years living in the land of Moav, both of Naomi's sons, Machlon and Kilyon, die, leaving the women without husbands or children.

News comes from Israel that the famine has lifted. Naomi decides to return to her <u>home</u> in Israel. Her two daughters-in-law, Orpah and Ruth, tell Naomi that they want to remain with her and return to her land. Naomi discourages them, telling them that they should live their lives fully and not <u>follow this</u> aged woman. She feels that she no longer has anything to offer them.

Orpah eventually decides to leave, but Ruth will not be dissuaded. She says to Naomi, "Do not urge me to leave you, to turn back and not follow you – for wherever you go, I will go, wherever you lie down, I will lie down. Your people shall be my people, and your God shall be my God." (Ruth 1:16)

Naomi and Ruth arrive home in Bethlehem. The townspeople hardly recognize Naomi. She says to them, "Don't call me Naomi (meaning pleasantness), call me Mara (meaning bitterness) because God has made my life bitter." (Ruth 1:20)

Once settled in the land, Ruth offers to become a gleaner, picking up grain behind the cutting crew in the fields. When Ruth chooses a field to glean in, by chance she chooses the field of Boaz (a relative of Naomi's).

One day, Boaz arrives in the field and his attention is drawn to Ruth. He learns of her identity, and because he has heard of her loyalty to Naomi and the Israelite people, he invites her to remain in his field until the end of the harvest.

Ruth returns to Naomi and informs her of where she has been working. Naomi explains that Boaz is an eligible kinsman to reclaim the family land and to wed Ruth, and she instructs Ruth on how to invite him to become her husband.

Boaz is pleased that Ruth came to him and he tells her that he will work to reclaim the property of Naomi's family and to marry Ruth. Boaz arranges for the necessary permission to acquire the land from a closer kinsman and to marry Ruth. At the city gate, a group of people gather together as witnesses to the marriage and bless the couple. The people give blessings to Ruth that she should be like Rachel and <u>Leah</u>.

At the end of the story, Ruth and Boaz have a son whom Naomi loves like her own child. The women of the town tell Naomi that her new grandson, Obed, will watch over her in old age, and that Ruth, her beloved daughter-in-law, is better to her than seven sons.

Shavuot is known as the Feast of Weeks in English and as <u>Pentecost</u> in Ancient Greek. It is a <u>Jewish holiday</u> that occurs on the sixth day of the Hebrew month of <u>Sivan</u>.

Shavuot has a double significance. It marks the all-important wheat harvest in Israel (Exodus 34:22), and it commemorates the <u>anniversary</u> of the day when God gave the <u>Torah</u> to the <u>nation of Israel</u> assembled at <u>Mount Sinai</u>—although the association is not explicit in the Biblical text between the giving of the Torah and Shavuot.

1 Sivan

- 1 Sivan Rosh Chodesh Sivan: According to *Rav Yehudah* today is the <u>start</u> of the summer season.
- 1 Sivan 2103 B.C.E.: The raging flood waters which covered the face of the earth in the Great Flood of Noah's time, calmed and began to subside at the rate of one cubit every four days, 150 days after the rain stopped falling. (Genesis 8:3).
- 1 Sivan 1522 B.C.E.: Jacob departs from Hebron (where his father Isaac and his grandfather Abraham lived) for Egypt to see his son *Yosef* / Joseph.

1 Sivan 2448 - 1313 B.C.E.: Six weeks after their exodus from Egypt, *Bnei Yisrael* arrived at Mount Sinai and camped at the foot of the mountain as one man, with one heart," in preparation for receiving the Torah from Hashem. On this day, however, Moshe did not give them any because of their exhaustion from the journey.

1 Sivan 2449 - 1312 B.C.E.: Korach met his end when he was miraculously swallowed up by the earth after leading a rebellion against Moses and his brother Aaron. "The ground split beneath them... And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their houses, and all the men that appertained to Korach, and all their possessions" (/ Numbers 16:31-32).

1 Sivan 4856 - May 25, 1096: Crusaders reached Cologne and found the gate to the city closed by order of the bishop. Of all the Jewish communities in the path of the Crusaders, Cologne's Jews were the only ones to escape total destruction.

1 Sivan 5727 - June 9, 1967: Day Five of the Six Day War.

We are entering the Hebrew month of Sivan along with Pentecost. As we go deeper into this time we will find life changing events knocking at our door. Each month unfolds new mysteries in His word. The prophetic guidepost appears as we journey from one place spiritually to another place seasonally. We are walking through a panacea of truth that will direct us to the next phase of what we have been assigned, as well as how we are to accomplish it. The key is to align ourselves with the understanding of this truth so that transformation may take place. We must be aware that by not making the adjustments is an indication that we are allowing issues within and circumstances without to keep us hindered. There is a prevailing theme that is flowing throughout the 3rd month, Sivan (we entered into it on June 3, 2019 until

July3, 2019). The most powerful thing about this month within the journey of Sivan the solution for God's people is discovered during the feast of Pentecost. Spiritually speaking this month represents the giving of the Torah to Israel. It also marks the Feast of (Shavuot) Pentecost which represents the giving of the Ruach Ha Kodesh.



The Release of Fire at Pentecost

There will be a great transitioning from the Body of Christ to the Bride of Christ in this hour of Pentecost. That which was washed away by cleansing waters will now see the fire of God removing old grave clothes, old wineskins, old dross, old mindsets that have been purged by fire baptism. It is one thing to wash out spots and blemishes but it is another to burn out that which is not a part of the growth process. When we look at the wheat and tares (especially during the grain harvest season) when the chaff is removed it is burned and reduced to ashes. We will see a fire baptism now that will be 7 times greater than what we have seen previously. Hearts and minds will become transformed under the fire of the Holy Ghost. The breath of the Messiah will keep the flames burning and the times will bear record of an awakening that many have cried out and prayed for in this hour. In the midst of this, we will see major changes and reversals. Events in the media will record drastic changes over night and without notice. This is an indication of a time to get one's life and house in order. The Lord who is a Consuming Fire will be

right in the midst of what will be occurring now.

We will also see in this season of Pentecost a new birthing and release of forerunners like John the Baptist who will run congruent with the remnant that will move forward in this hour you will know them as they echo the call to the people of God to repent and yield forth fruits of righteousness.

Acts 2: 1-: Chaplain Wade Butler


In five days Pentecost is celebrated. Get ready for the most explosive year in history... The Holy Spirit is at work.

And it was the end...of the beginning!

The events of Acts Chapter 2 are set against the backdrop of the celebration of Pentecost in Jerusalem. There are several major features to the Pentecost narrative presented in the second chapter of the Acts of the Apostles. The author begins the narrative by noting that the disciples of Jesus "were all together in one place" on the "day of Pentecost" (The verb used in Acts 2:1 to indicate the arrival of the day of Pentecost carries a connotation of fulfillment).

There is a "mighty rushing wind" (wind is a common symbol for the Holy Spirit) and "tongues as of fire" appear. The gathered disciples were "filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance". Some scholars have interpreted the passage as a reference to the multitude of languages spoken by the gathered disciples, while others have taken the reference to "tongues" to signify ecstatic speech. In Christian tradition, this event represents fulfillment of the promise that Christ will baptize his followers with the Holy Spirit. (Out of the four New Testament gospels, the distinction between baptism by water and the baptism by Christ with "Holy Spirit and fire" is only found in Matthew and Luke.)

Peter stated that this event was the beginning of a continual outpouring that would be available to all believers from that point on, Jews and Gentiles alike.



Matthew 16:19 (AMP), Acts 2:3, Acts 2:4

We are entering into the season of the Holy Spirit, keys will be given, power to overcome released. Take hold as we celebrate the Season of "Pentecost".

I will give you the keys (authority) of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth will have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you lose [permit, declare lawful] on earth will have [already] been loosed in heaven."

Acts 2:3, There appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were being distributed [among them], and they rested on each one of them [as each person received the Holy Spirit].

Acts 2:4, And they were all filled [that is, diffused throughout their being] with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues (different languages), as the Spirit was giving them the ability to speak out [clearly and appropriately].

But you will receive power and ability when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be MY witnesses [to tell people about Me] both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth.

¹⁴ But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them: "Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem let this be explained to you; listen closely *and* pay attention to what I have to say. ¹⁵ These people are not drunk, as you assume, since it is [only] the third hour of the day (9:00 a.m.); ¹⁶ but this is [the beginning of] what was spoken of through the prophet Joel:

- ¹⁷ 'And it shall be in the last days,' says God, 'That I will pour out My Spirit upon all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And your young men shall see [divinely prompted] visions, And your old men shall dream [divinely prompted] dreams; ¹⁸ Even on My Bond-servants, both men and women, I will in those days pour out My Spirit And they shall prophesy.
- ¹⁹ 'AND I WILL BRING ABOUT WONDERS IN THE SKY ABOVE AND SIGNS (attesting miracles) ON THE EARTH BELOW, BLOOD AND FIRE AND SMOKING VAPOR. ²⁰ 'THE SUN SHALL BE TURNED INTO DARKNESS AND THE MOON INTO BLOOD, BEFORE THE GREAT AND GLORIOUS DAY OF THE LORD COMES. ²¹ 'AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD [invoking, adoring, and worshiping the Lord Jesus] SHALL BE SAVED (rescued spiritually).'
- ²² "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man accredited *and* pointed out *and* attested to you by God with [the power to perform] miracles and wonders and signs which God worked through Him in your [very] midst, just as you yourselves know— ²³ this *Man*, when handed over [to the Roman authorities] according to the predetermined decision and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross and <u>put</u> to death by the hands of lawless *and* godless men. ²⁴ But God raised Him up, releasing Him *and* bringing an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in death's power. ²⁵ For David says of Him,

'I saw the Lord constantly before Me; For He is at My right hand, so that I will not be shaken [from my state of security]. 26 ' Therefore MY heart rejoiced and MY tongue exulted exceedingly; Moreover MY flesh also will live in hope [that is, will encamp in anticipation of the resurrection]; 27 'For You will not forsake ME and Abandon MY soul to Hades (the realm of the dead), Nor let Your Holy One undergo decay [after death].

 28 'You have made known to me the ways of life; You will fill me [infusing my soul] with Joy with Your presence.'

²⁹ "Brothers, I may confidently *and* freely say to you regarding the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. ³⁰ And so, being a prophet and knowing fully that GOD HAD SWORN TO HIM WITH AN OATH THAT HE WOULD SEAT *one* OF HIS DESCENDANTS ON HIS THRONE, ³¹ he foresaw and spoke [prophetically] of the resurrection of the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed), that HE WAS NOT ABANDONED [in death] TO HADES (the realm of the dead), NOR DID His body UNDERGO DECAY. ³² God raised this Jesus [bodily from the dead], and of that [fact] we are all witnesses. ³³ Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured out this [blessing] which you both see and hear. ³⁴ For David did not ascend into the heavens, yet he himself says,

'The Lord [the Father] said to My Lord [the Son], "Sit at My right hand, $^{\rm 35}$ Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."'

The Ingathering

³⁷ Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart [with remorse and anxiety], and they said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what are we to do?" ³⁸ And Peter said to them, "Repent [change your old way of thinking, turn from your sinful ways, accept and follow Jesus as the Messiah] and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ because of the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ For the promise [of the Holy Spirit] is for you and your children and for all who are far away [including the Gentiles], as many as the Lord our God calls to Himself." ⁴⁰ And Peter solemnly testified and continued to admonish *and* urge them with many more words, saying, "Be saved from this crooked *and* unjust generation!" ⁴¹ So then, those who accepted his message were baptized; and on that day about 3,000 souls were added [to the body of believers]. ⁴² They were continually *and* faithfully devoting themselves to the instruction of the apostles, and to fellowship, to eating meals together and to prayers.

⁴³ A sense of awe was felt by everyone, and many wonders and signs (attesting miracles) were taking place through the apostles. ⁴⁴ And all those who had believed [in Jesus as Savior] were together and had all things in common [considering their possessions to belong to the group as a whole]. ⁴⁵ And they *began* selling their property and possessions and were sharing the proceeds with all [the other believers], as anyone had need. ⁴⁶ Day after day they met in the temple [area] continuing with one mind, and breaking bread in various private <u>homes</u>. They were eating their meals together with joy and generous hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God *continually*, and having favor

³⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel recognize beyond all doubt that God has made Him both Lord and Christ (Messiah, Anointed)—this Jesus whom you crucified."

with all the people. And the Lord kept adding to their number daily those who were being saved.

"Don't call me Naomi," she told them. "Call me Mara, because the Almighty has made my life very bitter. I went away full, but the Lord has brought me back empty. Why call me Naomi? The Lord has afflicted me; the Almighty has brought misfortune upon me." Ruth 1:20, 21.

Trials can either make us bitter or better. They can be viewed as learning experiences that enhances growth, knowledge, and therefore maturity.

A Pastor shared that while he was away on a speaking engagement; his daughter who was a great athlete met in a tragic accident, and lost one of her leg. The Declaration of Repentance

We the People, the Holy Nation, a Holy People, as heirs to the Royal Priesthood; by blood birthright or through the blood birthright of the son of God the creator, Yeshua Christ, do hereby this day proclaim and declare:

We confess our personal sin of not honoring our parents and the elderly, and we repent of the sin of silence.

We have murdered.

We have murdered our brother with hatred in our heart.

We have murdered love with unforgiveness in our heart.

We have not given swift justice for bloodshed.

We have murdered the innocent with freedom of the guilty.

We have allowed the murder of the unborn.

We have allowed the murder of the elderly.

We confess our personal sin of murder, and we repent of the sin of silence.

We have committed adultery.

We have allowed open adulterers in positions of authority and in leadership before us. We have not questioned.

We have allowed open adulterers into Holy dwellings. We have not questioned.

We have allowed the murder of the unborn rooted in the sin of adultery.

We birthed the sin of adultery with the death of the unborn.

We have allowed the sexual perversions of sex change, sexual addictions, and sexual evil to become openly common.

We have promoted adultery in our children by allowing laws giving them rights to sexual materials and sexual activity. Even the young are legally permitted to murder the unborn, the result of adultery.

We have allowed the love of money to motivate decisions.

We have allowed laws giving rights for body parts of the living, the physically weak, the physically ill, or the physically near death, promoting the buying and selling of body parts, rooted from the love of money.

We have allowed the remains of dead bodies placed into vaccines of sickness and poison, placing impurities of the dead, and chemicals into our holy bodies, rooted from the love of money.

We repent of our personal love of money, and we repent of the sin of silence.


"How to Take Advantage of a New Era"

When God says something of this nature, we should take hold of it. When God declares it, we should believe it and <u>act</u> on it. Lisa and I knew we had to begin to act differently so we could take advantage of the opportunities of this new era. Therefore, I release a prophetic declaration that this is a new era. I decree and release it from the heavens. I decree and release a new era

right now, in Yeshua' name. Write it for yourself. Write down today's date and declare a new era.



A "New Era" is similar to "New Creation" where the Spirit moves.

Sometimes a new era is not recognized until it is history, but as prophetic people God lets us know before it happens. He does this so that we can participate in the acts that will become <u>history</u>, so that we can participate in them today, and in what will one day be a record of the new era that took place.

Your Boundaries are Changed

We want to make sure that we take advantage of the opportunities available to us in the now. It takes insight, wisdom and prophetic revelation to understand what's available to us now that wasn't available to us before. Many of you have lived in cycles and limitations that you know were true, but this is a new era. That means that your limitations are no longer limitations.

Your boundaries are changed. Your sphere is increased. Your actions have a greater impact than they did before. The fruit of your productivity will become greater than ever before.

Receive the New Era

Exodus 12:1-2 (KJV), "And the Lord spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying, "This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.""

In the beginning of a new calendar year, there is an excitement about the "something new." But there's also a time when God speaks into your current situation and says, "It's a new era for you." When He says, "It's a new year, "that means it's a new year for you – a new era. I want you to receive that right now. God is saying, "This month shall be the beginning of the year for you. "When God says that it's new, it's new!

Believe the New Era

Luke 4:16-22 (KJV), "And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: and, as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written, 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He hath anointed me to preach the Gospel to the poor; He hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord.' And He closed the book, and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him. And He began to say unto them, 'This day is this Scripture fulfilled in your ears.' And all bare Him witness and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, 'Is not this Joseph's son?'"

I wonder how many times the people in the synagogue heard this Scripture in past studies. How many times had they taken turns reading it? Yet on that day, Yeshua declared a new era. They had been expecting this Scripture to be fulfilled for so long, that on that day when Yeshua said, "This day is this Scripture fulfilled in your ears," they bore witness to Him and wondered at His words.

You've got to believe it. You can't just hear it. You must take hold of the new era. All who "bare Him witness" will see the new day. I don't care how many days you have spent believing in something to take hold. Today, God says, "This is the beginning of your new year. This is the day that Scripture is fulfilled. You've got to grab a hold of it and declare that this is a new era!"

Declare the New Era

What a difference a day makes. When you write something down, declare it and publish it, you're taking responsibility for what you believe and declaring it by faith. No matter what comes against you, no matter what lines up, or doesn't line up, you're taking responsibility.

July 4, 1776 was the day the Declaration of Independence was adopted. It contained a declaration and a date. The Declaration of Independence was the declaration of a new era.

January 1, 1863 was the day that President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation and a new era began. His dated and signed proclamation declared to the nations, "Let it be known that all slaves henceforth and forever are free" (paraphrased), and a new era began.

Own the New Era

Whether it was Hebrews, who were former Egyptian slaves, Jewish Believers, American representatives, or former American slaves, a group of people had to believe what was declared and had to engage in what was declared in order to benefit from their new era.

I want to encourage you to read the book by Booker T. Washington, *Up from Slavery*. I believe that every person of every color, no matter the <u>background</u>, who reads this book will be a better person. It will go deep into your soul and spirit. God used this man of keen wisdom and understanding to raise up a whole mass of people, so that they might burn with the desire and knowledge to have "a profitable operation of their calling."

What we cannot do is allow our darkest times to set the standard for the new era. Personally, and nationally, God has a higher standard. Booker T. was only 8 or 9 years old when he was freed. There were dark and despairing times when he worked in the coal mines of West Virginia, but he had hope in God concerning his

circumstance. He didn't limit his life to the darkest experience of slavery or the dark coal mines. He didn't set his expectations to the darkest time.

We cannot let what we've gone through in our lifetime, in our darkest moments, to set the standard for the new. Our habits will keep us in that same position if we don't grab a hold of God's promises for a new era. We need to act according to the promises of a new era.

As a former slave, Booker and his people could now walk off the plantation or the farm and no one was going to chase them. They could walk off because they were free. People began to walk around the town and the countryside because they could. They had never experienced that before and some were gone for hours while others never came back. Suddenly, as Booker T. described it, *the reality of freedom hit them*. A people, who had never provided for themselves, owned property, had a budget, a plan, paid taxes or voted were now in a position where they would have to learn the basics in life – things they'd never done before.

The blessing of freedom is not simply getting to do anything you want, because ultimately you may not want to do anything at all. You may want to just keep living life as you know it and not progress to the next best thing. The blessing of freedom is the ability to take ownership of yourself, your destiny and your next best thing. Freedom is not being free from work or labor, it just means that now you get to reward yourself with your own labor; the fruit of your labor is *yours*. So, we've got to act like and take steps in the knowledge that a new era is taking place. This new era is ours to make history in and to change circumstance through His promises to us.

There comes a moment in a new era when you must make the decision to act. You might believe or even decide to act, but when called to do so you must also be willing to take a new identity in and through Him. Before Booker T. went to school for the first time, he did not have a last name. As a slave he had no need of a last name. But when his teacher asked each student for their name, each responding with a first and last, at his turn he shouted out, "Booker Washington!" as if he had owned that name all his life.

Some of you have not taken up your new identity because you haven't had a need for it. God says, "It's now. I'm placing a demand on your mantle. I'm placing a demand on your calling. I'm placing a demand on your identity as My sons and daughters."

How to Live in Your New Era

What is your new era? What are the needs in this new era? If you'll take the time to answer these questions you will find the answers are very empowering. Personalize them: What is my new era? What are the needs in my new era?

The power of forgiveness will propel you in your new era. If you hold things against those who you've been dealing with, it's going to affect your new era.

You may be asking, "How can I best serve the Kingdom?" Well, Booker T. taught the first generation of free people how to lay down their lives for the next generation of free people. This provided them with a platform and a foundation on which to build their lives.

It's a new era. This is the first month of your new year. Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing. This is your independence day. This is your emancipation day. Take advantage of the opportunities in this, your new era. Don't believe that it's the same season. Try something different!

Let's Pray: Lord, we thank You for this new era. We thank You for a new year. We thank You for the things being fulfilled for us today. We thank You that You are fulfilling our every need and that by Your Blood, we have independence and emancipation from the things of the past. Thank You, Father, for what You're doing in us right now in this day, in this hour. We come into agreement with Your Word and Your plans. In Yeshua' name, Amen

5 Reasons Why You Should Pray in Yeshua Name by the SCHOOL OF LIFE

Have you heard other Christians praying in Yeshua' name, but can't figure out why? Well, I'm going to answer that question. Of course, the reality is so much bigger than that one question. The truth is that Yeshua name has an unparalleled authority and power that you and I and every other believer can <u>access</u>.

First, you must realize that Yeshua inherited His name from Almighty God. That means its God's own Name. It's the Name that in the Old Testament is translated LORD (as in Proverbs 18:10, "The name of the LORD is a strong tower"). It's the Name that was considered by the Israelites to be so powerful and holy that they reverenced it too much to say it and eventually the proper pronunciation was lost.

This is the most awesome, powerful Name that exists, and Yeshua obtained it by inheritance. It was conferred on Him after He purged our sin through the work of redemption, when He "sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high," and God said to Him, "Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of thy kingdom" (Hebrews 1:3, 8).

"Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth" (Philippians 2:9-10).

Just think of it! The Name Yeshua inherited, the Name God conferred on Him after His ascension to the throne of grace, is God's own divine Name. Therefore the only way to measure its greatness and grandness is by measuring the power of God Himself, and that can't be done.

God's power is immeasurable—and every bit of it is in His Name!

That's shouting ground right there, but it's not the whole story. According to Romans 8:17, you and I, as believers, are "heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ," so that Name belongs to us just as much as it belongs to Yeshua. It belongs to every bornagain child of God because, as the Apostle Paul said, it's the Name "of whom the whole family [of God] in heaven and earth is named" (Ephesians 3:15).

This is the reason the Church is referred to in Scripture as the bride of Christ. We've been covenanted to Him in a holy matrimony before God Almighty and, just as a bride takes the name of her husband in an earthly marriage, we've been given Yeshua' Name.

Most Christians haven't fully grasped this yet. They might have a little revelation of it. They might understand that they've been authorized to use Yeshua' Name at certain times to do the work of God. But that's just the tip of the iceberg. The truth is, we've not only been authorized to use His Name but we've been named after Him.

His Name is our name!

We have as much right to it as my wife, Gloria, has to the name Copeland. She doesn't have any qualms about using that name. She wields it with the same authority and confidence that I do. She can write it on a check, take it to the tellers at the bank, and

they'll smile and give her every last dime in my <u>account</u>. Why? It's her name and her account as much as it is mine.

The authority that's been invested in us as believers is beyond our wildest imaginations. Because we have God's Name, we not only have the right to speak for God, we have the right to speak by His grace as God. In fact, when we speak His Word by faith the devil can't tell the difference between us and God Himself. That's why it's so important to pray in Yeshua' name and to understand the power and authority available to us when we do.

When the enemy sees us coming his way, dressed in the spiritual armor described in Ephesians 6—wearing the belt of truth and breastplate of righteousness, our feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace, holding up the shield of faith, and looking at him through the faceplate of the helmet of salvation—the devil doesn't know who's in that armor. He just knows he's looking at God's fighting suit. So as far as he's concerned it's either the Father God Himself or His Son, The LORD Yeshua Christ.

"But Brother Copeland," you might say, "God and Yeshua are perfect. I'm not. Sometimes I sin or make mistakes. Won't the devil see that and realize it's just me inside that armor?"

Not if the moment you sin you immediately repent and run to the throne of grace. Yeshua is always there and He's faithful and just to forgive and to <u>cleanse</u> you of all unrighteousness—instantly, right on the spot. There's nothing the devil can do about it, either, because your righteousness isn't based on your own perfect performance. It's a gift from your heavenly Father who sent Yeshua to be made "sin for us...that we might be made the righteousness of God in him" (2 Corinthians 5:21).

I'm talking to you about praying in the name of Yeshua. But really, I'm teaching you that you are qualified to wear God's armor and wield His authority. Yes, sometimes we'll make mistakes and fall short, but that doesn't mean we will ever lose our connection with Yeshua. By faith we're in Him. He's the head and we're the body.

Even in a natural sense, the head and the body don't have two different identities. When I walk into a room no one ever says, "Here comes Brother Copeland and his body." No, the head and the body are one. They have the same identity and the same name.

That's how it is with us and Yeshua. We're one. We have the same authority He does. We wear the same armor, and we have the same all-powerful Name!

Hebrews 2:11-14 says it this way:


For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren, saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.... Behold I and the children which God hath given me. Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil.

At times, when you put on the armor of God, you may feel like it's too big for you. You may be aware that you have some growing to do spiritually before you fill it out. But that doesn't change the fact that, according to those verses, the Lord Yeshua Christ has called you His brother. You're born of God just as surely as He is. You and He have the same DNA. Spiritually, you're identical twins.

It's no wonder the devil is terrified of you. It's no wonder he flees when you resist him!

You bear the Name of the One who conquered him in awesome, awful combat in the pit of hell. You bear the Name of the One who destroyed him and stripped him of his authority. The all-victorious One who, "having spoiled principalities and powers...made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it" (Colossians 2:15).

No matter what you encounter, have faith in the name of Yeshua. Take your place, seated with Him in heavenly places—"Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named" (Ephesians 1:21). It's your chance to overcome every obstacle!

The Days of His Presence

Nearly every Christian I know believes we are in the closing hours of this age. How close to the end, no one knows; and when Yeshua will return, none presume a guess. If our hope has truly come from Heaven, then the praying, hungering church of Yeshua Christ is about to enter a season of extraordinary manifestations of God's glory. We are about to engage in what Bible scholars call a dispensational move of God's Spirit. During such times, the Lord has always manifested Himself in glory.

It is true that no one has seen the Father's glory, but God the Son has manifested Himself in glory numerous times in the past. Abraham saw Christ's glory while he was in Mesopotamia. Isaiah beheld Him in the year King Uzziah died. Ezekiel fell before the Living One by the river Chebar. Daniel, David, Habakkuk, Solomon, Zachariah, and Haggai all saw the glory of the Lord. *In truth, the Bible was written by people who had seen God's glory!*

Moses beheld God, then Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, and the seventy Hebrew elders as well. Exodus tells us these men "saw the God of Israel; and under His feet there appeared to be a pavement of sapphire, as clear as the sky itself" (Ex. 24:10). Of their encounter with the Almighty, we read, "and they saw God, and they ate and drank" (v. 11).

Think of it: "They saw God!" Is there not a jealousy within you for that experience -- to actually gaze upon the glory of God? To behold the Lord's glory is not only scriptural, but it's also typical during dispensational moves of God. The fact is, over three million Israelites saw God's glory on Mount Sinai. Young men, old women, and little children -- people of every age and physical condition -- all saw "the glory of the Lord [as it] rested on Mount Sinai" (Ex. 24:16)!

Yet that unveiling of glory did not stop at Sinai. The entire Hebrew nation followed a cloud of glory by day and was illuminated by a blazing pillar of fire-like glory at night. This happened not just once or twice but every day for forty years! How much more shall the Lord of glory manifest Himself to us at the end of the age?

Yeshua said that he who is least in His kingdom is greater than those under the old covenant (Matt. 11:11). In what ways are Christ's followers "greater"? Those in the Old Testament saw His glory from a distance, but He has chosen to reveal His glory *in* and *through* the church! Is it not written, He is coming to be "glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed" (2 Thess. 1:10)?

Indeed, Yeshua has not only given us His name and His words (John 17:6, 14), but He has also granted us to partake of His radiant splendor! The very glory that was manifest in the Old Testament He now has deposited in the spirits of those washed in His blood. He said, "The glory which You have given Me I have given to them" (John 17:22).

Yes, God will again reveal His glory at the end of the age. The unsaved world will receive one last, legitimate opportunity to choose, not merely between the church and the sin, but between the radiance of Heaven and the horrors of hell. In truth, at the end of the age, both realms will be manifested in fullness on earth.

"God's Perfect Plan in This Season" Anne Ballard, Redding, CA

God is True to His Word

God is faithful to His plans. Nothing can block or stop His purposes on the earth. For instance, take the story of Jacob and Esau. In Genesis 25:23 the Lord spoke directly to Rebekah about the children she would give birth to when He said, "...Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples from within you will be separated; one people will be stronger than the other, and the older will serve the younger."

Although tradition dictated that the birthright went to the oldest son, Jacob convinced Esau to surrender it when Esau was desperately hungry one afternoon (Genesis 25:29-34). Later in Genesis 27, Jacob fools his father into giving him the blessing instead of Esau. Tradition did not allow for the younger son to receive the birthright and the blessing from the older son, but it was what God had prophesied to Rebekah before her sons were even born. God had a purpose in blessing Jacob which declared that Jacob would be the younger son, and because of that, even tradition couldn't stand in the way of God's purposes.

What does this mean for you? It means that no matter how things may appear, what the test results say, or even what your bank account reads, God will be true to His word. His answer may not add up or make sense, but He who promised is faithful (Hebrews 10:23). Stand in faith this month on the words that He has given you, hold onto the promises He's spoken to your spirit, and don't let go of what you know in your heart to be true.

His ways are not our ways and His plans are not our plans (Isaiah 55:8-9), so the chances are likely that His plans won't make sense according to Earth's standards. When you are able to stand in faith, you will see the unmistakable hand of God move on your behalf this month.

The Promise of Life

"Then Abraham prayed to God, and God healed Abimelek, his wife and his female slaves so they could have children again, for the Lord had kept all the women in Abimelek's household from conceiving because of Abraham's wife Sarah." (Genesis 20:17-18)

God is declaring, "I am healing the wombs of My people." Just as He did in Genesis 20 in the story of Abraham and Abimelek, God is once again opening wombs. Women who have been told they will never bear children, bodies that haven't been able to carry a baby to term, women past childbearing age, and those who haven't ever been able to conceive will finally become pregnant. God is removing roadblocks (previous problems, faulty anatomies, or emotional distresses) that have prevented viable pregnancies in the past. Stand in faith this month, continuing to believe for your promise. God's promise of life is undeniable, unshakable, and irrefutable.

Restored Connection

"And He will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers..." (Malachi 4:6 NKJV)

God is restoring parents and children. Parents, you will find supernatural grace to let go of the ways you've failed or the ways you feel like you've failed your children. As you release this shame, it will open up an avenue for you to connect to your children in greater measure.

If you are a parent who has struggled with this feeling and you have confessed your failings to God, know that He has already released and forgiven you for what has been

holding you up in your mind and heart from truly connecting with your children. The shame and regret over past mistakes (or perceived mistakes) has prevented you from allowing yourself to be loved, and from accepting yourself. As you release yourself from shame, you will open the door for your children to accept you and reconcile with you. As you watch for opportunities to receive God's love for yourself, you may see things shift in relationships with estranged children this month.

Organic Discipleship

"Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience." (Colossians 3:12)

Discipline someone can at times feel daunting, and it is easy to disqualify yourself because you don't feel like you measure up, or that you're far enough along to be leading someone else. There is a way for discipleship to feel more organic and easy. Some old ideas of what discipleship feels like are not actually founded in truth. It doesn't have to be so hard!

God is reminding us that we all have the capacity to disciple, and that we need to be discipled, too. Authenticity, surrender, and willingness are what is required to be successful at leading others. Those following you will be encouraged and strengthened by your willingness to share your own mistakes and failures. Just as they stepped out in humility to seek someone to disciple them, humility is also required of you to lead them into truth. God's design for discipleship requires humility on both sides.

Watch for opportunities, even this month, to lead someone near you, and to be led by someone who's farther along than you are. Humility may just open that door. The Body of Christ needs leaders who are authentic in their leadership, and you are called to be a part of that transformation.

Pat Francis:" "So he answered and said to me:
"This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power,
but by My Spirit,' Says the LORD of hosts.

"Who are you, O Great Mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain! And he shall bring forth the capstone with shouts of "Grace, grace to it!" Zechariah 4:6-7.

God gave this word to the prophet Zerubbabel as he was being commissioned to work with God in a project that needed amazing miracles. First, under the kingship of King Cyrus, he led the first group of Jewish captives, who were living in exile, back to Jerusalem. They also returned with the gold and silver vessels which King Nebuchadnezzar had stolen from the Temple after it was destroyed.

Then, under Zerubbabel leadership, the Jews started to rebuild the Temple that was previously destroyed during the war. The foundation took two years to build and then the construction came to a standstill for 17 years. They faced opposition from settlers in Samaria who disrupted the building project and later suffered court battles which resulted in King Cyrus withdrawing his support.

Zerubbabel, nevertheless, had to encourage himself in the Lord to keep the vision alive. He diligently resumed work on the Temple with a renewed effort by God's Spirit and favor. He grew in favor with God because of his steadfast faith and God made him grow in favor with people. Prophets, Persian kings, and influential people rallied around him in support, prayer, and provision. God's word proved true and the Temple was rebuilt by the Spirit of God.

It is never easy to do great accomplishments as opposition and trials will always come. Yeshua warns us and encourages us, "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33. You will overcome.

"One of the Most Important Gifts Given to Man"

God impressed upon my heart to share one of the most important and powerful gifts given to man from the Holy Spirit. The last century we have witnessed a restoration of the infilling of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues, the nine gifts of the Spirit, and the five-fold ministry offices. During this present hour many have become infatuated and enthralled in particular by the gift of prophecy.

One way this has become evident is that prophetic gatherings have multiplied in number and grown in size. Prophecy, as well as the other gifts of the Spirit, have such a powerful ability to change lives and impact destinies of individuals. However, there is one gift of equal, if not greater, vitality and importance. This gift is commonly untaught, rarely mentioned, and often not considered "a gift" from God.

No revival, reformation, or major shift in Christianity has occurred without this gift being prominent. Sure some revivals have been earmarked by prophecy, healing, or salvation but this gift was still foundational in each instance. I'm sure you are wondering what gift this is. It is the gift of spiritual hunger. Many times we have not recognized spiritual hunger as a gift.

Every revival and reformation started with men and women who were hungry for God to be made real in the earth. They were people who were willing to sacrifice themselves for the sake of the Kingdom of God and truth. Every revival had a <u>start</u> with a group of people whose hearts were prepared and hungry to see God in a greater fullness. Luke 8:40, "And it came to pass, that, when Yeshua was returned, the people gladly received Him: for they were all waiting for Him. "There is an expectancy and joyful reception of the things of God from those who are spiritually hungry. As spiritual hunger increases one is less bound by religion and more readily able to enter into "present truth" (see 2 Peter 1:12).

How I Discovered Spiritual Hunger

Even in my own life I did not realize that this is a divine blessing from God. I discovered this truth when I was a young man and then again as a mature Believer.

One summer when I was 13 years old I spent hours each day studying the Word of God. I awoke once more with an intense sensation of hunger. Hurriedly, I prepared breakfast for myself. As I went to lift the fork loaded with a pancake to my mouth I had an epiphany of truth. It was not physical food that I was hungry for but I was hungry for the Word of God. I was hungry to know God in a real way. I left the breakfast table and opened up my Bible and read for a half hour until my spiritual appetite subsided.

Matthew 4:4, "...Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God." The Word of God gives us life. As we dig into it more and more God blesses us, not just with head knowledge but an increased appetite to know Him and His ways. The Psalmist King David wrote in Psalms 63:1, "O God, thou art my God; early will I seek Thee; my soul thirsteth for Thee, my flesh longeth for Thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is."

I believe that King David was a man after God's own heart (1 Samuel 13:14) because the Holy Spirit had first deposited an intense hunger for God in his heart. He expressed his hunger for God's presence as "my flesh longs for Thee." Although he was king and had access to the finest the kingdoms of Judah and Israel could provide, he describes it as a "dry and thirsty land." When one is truly hungry for God nothing can satisfy one's soul but God Himself.

Draw Me

Many Believers desire to run hard after the things of God but often find themselves challenged by spiritual lethargy. I would like to share a powerful prayer found in Scripture that will help to overcome this obstacle. Song of Solomon 1:4, "Draw me, we will run after thee: the king hath brought me into his chambers: we will be glad and rejoice in thee, we will remember thy love more than wine: the upright love thee." In this passage we discover that one is able to run for God after God draws us. "Draw me, we will run after thee." The grace of spiritual hunger causes us to be drawn to the things of God (worship, prayer, preaching, prayer, and study). Many have little interest for the deeper things of God because they have not asked God to draw them deeper in Him. If we ask

with a sincere heart God will indeed draw us into greater truths and closer to His person.

Divine Timing

Once an emerging prophet was telling me about how hungry he was for God. Also, how much time he spent reading and praying daily. I shared with him, "Enjoy it now. It won't always be that way. God has blessed you with this ability now to prepare you for later." He disagreed with me and said he would sustain his rate of prayer and devotion. A year later he called me and said, "What you told me was right. I'm praying daily but not as much as before. I try to read for hours but can only read twenty or so minutes." I had experienced this in my own spiritual walk. There were seasons where God deposited within my heart an intense spiritual hunger which made it easy to pray and study for hours. When this grace lifted, I was back to my regular devotion. The times of intensity were to prepare me for the times of fruitfulness and productivity in ministry.

Fasting

Fasting is one Kingdom key to increase one's spiritual hunger. Fasting, when done properly, causes us to block out distractions that hinder us from receiving from God. It positions us to get "clear" about what God is desiring to say to us and do in us. The affairs of life and demonic bondages that compete with God for our attention are put to the side as we seek God.

Fasting also says to God that one means business with Him. God honors seeking Him with a greater desire (hunger) to seek Him.

God cannot pour more into our person without first enlarging our capacity to receive from Him. A new hunger often precedes new wineskins (heart change) and new wine (truth, revelation) being poured out from God.

Luke 5:37-38, "And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish. But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved."

A Powerful Prayer

Dear Father God in Heaven, I humbly come before You in the name of Your Son, Yeshua Christ. I ask that You will forgive me for any spiritual neglect or laziness.

Lord, help me to serve You with a fervent mind and fervent spirit. Please allow Your Holy Spirit to increase my hunger for You, Your Word, and the things of God. Draw me by Your Spirit that I may run for You. Draw me by Your Spirit that I may be consumed with Your love and truth. I thank You now, Father that You have heard my prayer and I expect a renewal in my spiritual walk in Yeshua Christ's name.

WHAT YOU HAVE FELT HAS CONQUERED YOU, YOU WILL NOW CONQUER!!! By Lana Vawser Ministries

I heard the Lord say over many in the body of Christ "What you have felt has conquered you, you will now conquer".

SYNONYMNS: defeat, beat, vanquish, trounce, annihilate, triumph over, be victorious over, best, get the better of, worst, bring someone to their knees, overcome, overwhelm, overpower, overthrow, subdue, subjugate, put down, quell, quash, crush, repress, rout; (Definition from Google)

The Lord showed me many have felt CONQUERED in this season by intense opposition, battles, trials and temptations. Many have felt like they are going "around and around the mountain" with no end in sight and even feeling like it's getting harder each time they go round again.

The feeling has increased of "I'm being conquered by this..." and the feeling of "there's no end in sight" has been getting stronger for many.

This morning I had a vision and I saw many of God's people holding swords and they were using the swords to come against these things that are leaving many feeling like they are continually being 'conquered' by them I watched as God's people continued to use the sword of the Word of God and over and over again they continued to stab this thing opposing God's promise/s in their lives. 

Romans 8:1-24 (AMP) Escape from Bondage

Therefore there is now no condemnation [no guilty verdict, no punishment] for those who are in Christ Yeshua [who believe in Him as personal Lord and Savior]. For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Yeshua [the law of our new being] has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For what the Law could not do [that is, overcome sin and remove its penalty, its power] being weakened by the flesh [man's nature without the Holy Spirit], God did: He sent His own Son in the likeness of sinful man as an offering for sin. And He condemned sin in the flesh [subdued it and overcame it in the person of His own Son], so that the [righteous and just] requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not live our lives in the ways of the flesh [guided by worldliness and our sinful nature], but [live our lives] in the ways of the Spirit [guided by His power].

For those who are living according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh [which gratify the body], but those who are living according to the Spirit, [set their minds on] the things of the Spirit [His will and purpose]. Now the mind of the flesh is death [both now and forever—because it pursues sin]; but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace [the spiritual well-being that comes from walking with God—both now and forever]; the mind of the flesh [with its sinful pursuits] is actively hostile to God. It does not submit itself to God's law, since it cannot, and those who are in the flesh [living a life that caters to sinful appetites and impulses] cannot please God.

However, you are not [living] in the flesh [controlled by the sinful nature] but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God lives in you [directing and guiding you]. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him [and is not a child of God]. If Christ lives in you, though your [natural] body is dead because of sin, your spirit is alive because of righteousness [which He provides]. ¹And if the Spirit of Him who raised Yeshua from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Yeshua from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.

Sivan 20: June 23, 2019





"God is Removing Your Obstacles! Push Open That Door!"

The Lord shared with me that 2019 will be the year where He removes obstacles in our lives. Those things that have been opposing and oppressing us will

be immediately dealt with and moved out of the way The Scripture that God gave me to support this prophetic word is 1 Corinthians 9:9-11:

"For it is written in the Law of Moses: 'Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain.' Is it about oxen that God is concerned? Surely He says this for us, doesn't He? Yes, this was written for us, because whoever plows and threshes should be able to do so in the hope of sharing in the harvest. If we have sown spiritual seed among you, is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you?"

While speaking to the church of Corinth, Apostle Paul reflects on a word that was spoken to Moses by the Lord in the Old Testament. When this Scripture admonishes someone not to muzzle an ox while it's treading out the grain, what God is really saying is this: Absolutely nothing should be done to impair an ox from working when it's operating at its optimal level. The ox is one animal used in Scripture to describe a woman or man who is diligent and tenacious in getting God's work done.

Therefore, God is saying to us that as we've cross into this new year of 2019, just like the ox, there will be no evil force that can muzzle or impair us from moving forward when we are advancing in His purposes. Furthermore, God is going to enable us to advance at optimum levels. The Lord is recognizing our hard labor from the last season and He is promising us that our tenacity and diligence will be rewarded in this season.

Whoever Plows Must Also Reap

Many of you reading this article have remained steadfast and dedicated to His call for your life, even though it has seemed as though you have been reaping little fruit. This is why the Lord says in 1 Corinthians 9:10 that whoever plows and threshes should also reap. When this Scripture references plowing and threshing, it is referring to the portion *prior* to enjoying the benefits of harvesting. This is when you have to do the hard, boring and tedious work right before you experience breakthrough. However, the ox continues to do this hard work with the earnest expectation that when it's complete, it will reap the rewards of harvest.

I hear the Lord saying this to you: "You have been working very hard doing things that have been hard, tedious, and sometimes very unenjoyable. Yet, I say to you this day that you are about to reap the blessings that come with being faithful to My call. I will not allow your work to be muzzled and shut down without blessing you. You will reap the rewards of your labor as I remove your obstacles from out of your pathway."

Although the Door May Be Closed, It is Not Locked

While in church service the last Sunday of 2018, my pastor asked me to share with the congregation about what I heard our Lord saying concerning 2019. As I began to share this word that I'm sharing with you, I had a very strong prophetic vision. In the vision, I

was standing in a hallway and I was about to go down what was a new walkway. I was very excited about the opportunity of walking down this new path. However, as soon as I began to continue my walk, I noticed this big, beautiful, solid, gold door. I couldn't help but admire how beautiful the door was, yet I became very disappointed because I realized the door was closed.

I looked at the door and also noticed that there was no doorknob and it appeared to be very heavy, like a vault door. I then heard the Holy Spirit say, "Put your hand on the door." So I pressed my palms on the door and it immediately flung open. I was amazed that it was not as heavy as it looked. I was also surprised that although the door was closed, it was not locked.

The prophetic vision came with a very clear message: In 2019 we may face what appear to be doors that are closed. But, even though these doors may appear to be closed, God is saying that they are not locked. Furthermore, with just a little effort, these doors are going to fling wide open.

What does this mean in practical terms? As you endeavor to move forward in God's purpose for your life this year, God wants you to understand that He is going to contend with anything that tries to oppose you, and if that opposition refuses to move out of the way for you, God will supernaturally move it out of your way.

Removing Satan's Armor

"When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own house, his possessions are undisturbed. But when someone stronger than he attacks him and overpowers him, he takes away from him all his armor on which he had relied and distributes his plunder" (Luke 11:21-22).

Before we were saved, Satan was like a fully armed "strong man" guarding the homestead of our souls. On the day of our salvation, however, "someone stronger," the Lord Jesus Christ, attacked and overpowered Satan and stripped him of his armor. Our born-again experiences may be widely varied, but in the spirit-realm, a very similar war was waged and won for each of us if we could have seen into the invisible world, we would have observed the Holy Spirit working with the angels of God to overpower and destroy the enemy's "armor."

What exactly was this armor that protected the devil and kept us from salvation? The armor upon which demons rely consists of our own thoughts, attitudes and opinions that are in agreement with evil.

What Jesus described as "armor," the apostle Paul classified as "strongholds" (2 Cor. 10:1-4 NKJV). It is important to recognize that, in speaking of strongholds, the apostle

was addressing the church. It is foolish to assume that there are no strongholds in our hearts and minds. Our salvation experience has overpowered the enemy, but it has not eliminated all the wrong ideas and attitudes -- the strongholds -- that are still influencing our perception and behavior. Yes, old things passed away; true, new things have come. But until we are walking in the fullness of Christ, we should not assume that the process of transformational change is over.

On an individual level, the foundation of our continued success in warfare comes from yielding to the Lord as He reveals these strongholds and agreeing with Him through repentance in pulling them down.

It is important to recognize that when we speak of strongholds we are not talking about random thoughts or occasional sins. Perhaps the strongholds that affect us most are those that are so blended into our thinking patterns that we do not recognize them nor identify them as evil. Remember, in our initial text, Jesus revealed that unclean spirits are seeking "rest." The sense of rest they seek originates from being in harmony with their environment. In other words, when our thought-life is in agreement with unbelief, fear or habitual sin, the enemy has rest.

It is significant that when the Holy Spirit enters our lives many changes occur suddenly. However, we should not be surprised if the process of deliverance should involve a season of inner conflict and turmoil. This is a good sign, signifying the individual's will desire to be free. We should expect a time where we must exercise our authority in Christ as we "resist" the devil (1 Pet. 5:8-9).

Paul speaks of the "struggle" of the church against principalities and powers (Eph. 6:12). There will be a period of fighting involved in the process of pulling down strongholds, for you are breaking your agreement with a foe that will fight to remain in your life.

There are satanic strongholds over countries and communities, and there are strongholds that even influence, to some degree, churches and individuals. Wherever a stronghold exists, it is a demonically induced pattern of thinking. Specifically, it is a "house made of thoughts" that has become a dwelling place for satanic activity.

A Prayer to Remove Obstacles

If you are in agreement with the word that God is removing your obstacles in 2019, please pray this prayer after me:

Dear Heavenly Father, You said in Your Word that if I believe in the Word of the Lord, I will prosper. I believe that in 2019, You are removing every obstacle in my life. And although it may appear as I move in Your Word that there are doors which seem to be

closed, I realize that these doors are not locked, but merely opportunities for You to prove who You are in my life. I will receive Your direction on how to open these doors and when I do, they will fling wide open. I decree now: DOORS OPEN IN JESUS' NAME! AMEN.

"THE SERVICE OF OUR FAITH" By Ricci Wilson

The refining process takes us deeper in God. In fact, what is taking place in this hour is deeper and presses us harder than at any time in our history. Why? Because the Lord is shedding off the old man to bring us into a new place in Him. The refining is birthing a new breed of believers who will walk in the fullness of Christ. We will have such an inflowing of Christ that when you come into contact with people, those who have that deep ache in them that cries out to know God, they will see that you are a child of God and they will come to you to find out how to know Him. It is a transformation of who we are into the person who reflects the Son of God.

Consider the false Unity Movement running rampant through our churches today. I can see how the deception has been allowed. Why? Because there is so much compromise in the Church. Compromise opens the door to deception. When a pastor becomes a stumbling block to his congregation, it is time for him to be removed. I say that with great fear and trepidation, knowing that it has a deep impact on the congregation. My heart aches for the churches consumed by this movement. God is looking for those who will lead, serve and reflect God, whether they are in the pulpit, on the side of the road, or by the river. Are they individuals who will emanate God to the people they have in their care? It is not supposed to be about money, a building, or programs. What God wants to know is, are you demonstrating the love of the living God to your congregation and living out a life of righteousness before them?

God is allowing this false movement in order to refine the church. He's no longer going to permit pastors to be a stumbling block to their congregations. He is going to remove them and put someone in their place who will lead people to Him. He is the living God and if we are a stumbling block to others, He will remove us. This is not just for pastors; it is across the leadership in the Church.

Honestly, my cry is that I will not be a stumbling block to others, and I take that seriously, down to the littlest details. Some people place the little "testimony" bumper stickers on their cars to show that they belong to the Lord. They have a fish or a WWJD sticker and I do think some of them are pretty cute but the truth is, I cannot place one of those on my truck. I've always felt as though it's so much pressure! What if I cut someone off by mistake one day and they see that sticker on my car and then decide that I'm a typical Christian who just cuts people off the road? What if I receive a phone call while I'm driving that brings really bad news, but they just see my anger or my tears and feel that is ungodly? I never want to put the name of Christ or the name of God in jeopardy. I am human and I am guaranteed to make a mistake. That 3-second interaction with me with zero contexts is all that person has, and I do not want to risk affecting them in a negative way.

The Lord is calling forth a new breed of believers, those will demonstrate the love of God, receive those who are weak in the faith, and refuse to stand in judgement of their brethren. Romans 14 instructs us to not stand in judgment of our brother. The words "judge/judgment" in verses 3, 10 and 14 mean, "to pick out by separating" and refer to "those who judge severely (unfairly) finding fault with this or that in others." In Romans 14, verses 3 & 10, the word "despise" means "to count as nothing, to treat with utter contempt—as zero." Let's look a bit more at the history of why Paul was issuing this instruction.

In Rome, we had both Jews and Gentiles. History alone paves a path of conflict between them. The acceptance of Christ did not create an automatic unity among them. These are the chosen and the grafted vessels working to set aside the past, shed off the old, and enter a new walk in Christ. This is altogether different from anything they have previously experienced. With persecution so prevalent in this young church, many were forced into communities. Formerly, they lived rigidly separate lives, Jews and Gentiles, "the chosen" and "the heathen." These two groups were like night and day; every part of their lives was different from the other down to the smallest detail. Every part, from what they ate and how they prepared what they ate, to cleansing rituals, worship, and on and on. One event brought them together—their acceptance of Yeshua Christ as their Savior. That single event merged them into a community and now they shared everything. This provided plenty of opportunity for conflict, judgment, separation, finding fault, and so on.

Paul, in his letter to the Church of Rome, is working to bring unity among them that they might live in harmony. This is not a false unity like we've seen recently, but a Christ-centered unity, one without judgment, hatred, or despising one another. His encouragement is to refrain from diminishing who a person is, their background, their strengths or weaknesses. Why? Because in doing so, especially to one who is new in the faith, causes a stumbling block to them as they grow in Christ. Better a milestone be hung about our neck than for us to be a stumbling block to a new believer.

Consider the "Pillars of our Faith" (from Romans chapters 5-8) and the impact those four pillars are supposed to have upon our lives. Repentance, sanctification, justification, and reconciliation are supposed to penetrate our lives so deeply that it breaks off legalism, it breaks off the flesh, it breaks off the things that divide people! I am not talking about a unity movement, I am talking about things that cause us to separate ourselves, because the truth is, God wants to impart a level of truth and understanding of who He is into the Body of Christ because it will transform us!

1John 3:23-4:3 AMP

This is His commandment, that we believe [with personal faith and confident trust] in the name of His Son Yeshua Christ, and [that we unselfishly] love and seek the best for one another, just as He commanded us. The one who habitually keeps His commandments [obeying His word and following His precepts, abides and] remains in Him, and He in him. By this we know and have the proof that He [really] abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us [as a gift].

Testing the Spirits

Beloved, do not believe every spirit [speaking through a self-proclaimed prophet]; instead test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets and teachers have gone out into the world. By this you know and recognize the Spirit of God: every spirit that acknowledges and confesses [the fact] that Yeshua Christ has [actually] come in the flesh [as a man] is from God [God is its source]; and every spirit that does not confess Yeshua [acknowledging that He has come in the flesh, but would deny any of the Son's true nature] is not of God; this is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming, and is now already in the world.

2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace [every favor and earthly blessing] come in abundance to you, so that you may always [under all circumstances, regardless of the need] have complete sufficiency in everything [being completely self-sufficient in Him], and have an abundance for every good work *and* act of charity.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Pat Francis: Encourage Yourself

"And the people, that is, the men of Israel, encouraged themselves and again formed the battle line at the place where they had put themselves in array on the first day." Judges 20:22.

There are times when you will have only one encourager - YOU. Here the men of Israel had to encourage themselves after two disappointing battles. They had gone into battle with self-confidence and self-righteousness and suffered severe loss. They examined their approach, attitude towards God, and in humility they sought His favor. This time God responded: "Go, for tomorrow I will give them into your hands." Judges 20:28. They battled again and won. Without encouragement it's hard to continue in faith and success.

The bible contains many examples of people and nations that suffered severe loss but recovered all. In some cases, they gained more than they had before their crisis. They all had to fight a common enemy - discouragement. David after a severe loss (his family, resources, tents, workers, friend), was greatly distressed. He cried, prayed, and cried some more as the enemy of discouragement tried to swallow him in a pit of despair: "David was greatly distressed; for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God." 1 Samuel 30:6.

There are times when you have no one but YOU to encourage YOU. You have the power to encourage yourself with the word of God, by praising God and with thanksgiving. God's word to you: "For I am with you to rescue and save you, 'declares the LORD." Jeremiah 15:20.

Hebrews 2:14-18 (AMP)

Therefore, since [these His] children share in flesh and blood [the physical nature of mankind], He Himself in a similar manner also shared in the same [physical nature, but without sin], so that through [experiencing] death He might make powerless (ineffective, impotent) him who had the power of death—that is, the devil—and [that He] might free all those who through [the haunting] fear of death were held in slavery throughout their lives. For, as we all know, He (Christ) does not take hold of [the fallen] angels [to give them a helping hand], but He does take hold of [the fallen] descendants of Abraham [extending to them His hand of deliverance]. Therefore, it was essential that He had to be made like His brothers (mankind) in every respect, so that He might [by experience] become a merciful and faithful High Priest in things related to God, to make atonement (propitiation) for the people's sins [thereby wiping away the sin, satisfying divine justice, and providing a way of reconciliation between God and mankind]. Because He Himself [in His humanity] has suffered in being tempted, He is able to help and provide immediate assistance to those who are being tempted and exposed to suffering.

Hebrews 3:1-6 (AMP)

Yeshua Our High Priest

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, [thoughtfully and attentively] consider the Apostle and High Priest whom we confessed [as ours when we accepted Him as Savior], namely, Yeshua; He was faithful to Him who appointed Him [Apostle and High Priest], as Moses also was *faithful* in all God's house. Yet Yeshua has been considered worthy of much greater glory *and* honor than Moses, just as the builder of a house has more honor than the house. For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God. Now Moses was faithful in [the administration of] all God's house, [but only] as a *ministering* servant, [his ministry serving] as a testimony of the things which were to be spoken afterward [the revelation to come in Christ]; but Christ is faithful as a Son over His [Father's] house. And we are His house if we hold fast our confidence and sense of triumph in our hope [in Christ].


